

A Note from Your Pastor

My brothers and sisters in the Lord,

During these uncertain times, I just wanted to drop you a note to bring you up to speed about some aspects of our parish life. As many of you also experienced during the night of Friday, March 27, all of the roofs on our parish buildings received significant impacts from the hailstorm. Four windows on the apse of church were broken and the church tower received further damage during that event.

The Adoration Chapel and side ramp into church will remain closed until such time as a protective structure can be erected to protect those walkways from clay roof tiles that continue to slide off the church. At this point, we are still waiting to receive complete bids from various roofing companies, as well as receiving a scope of work from our major insurance carrier.

Through the generosity of the estate of Ethel Bruning, the rotted and warped doors at the main entrance of church were replaced. Many thanks to the members of our Parish Property Committee for years of deliberations on that project.

By this point, you are probably aware that the remainder of the school year has been cancelled. Although we had been planning on our younger parishioners receiving their First Holy Communion this weekend, that obviously is not possible. Not knowing the extent to which the COVID-19 pandemic will continue, I do not think it would be wise to propose another date for First Holy Communion or Confirmation at this time.

Finally, on behalf of Fr. Basil and myself, I want to thank all of you for your continued financial generosity to our Parish and School, as well as your kind cards and edible gifts brought to the front porch of the rectory.

COVID -19 update

Questions parishioner ask:

Do I need to wear a mask? CDC recommends wearing cloth face coverings in public when social distancing measures are difficult to maintain (e.g., grocery stores and pharmacies) especially in areas of significant community-based transmission of the coronavirus. The purpose of wearing cloth face coverings in public is to slow the spread of the virus and help keep people who may have the virus and do not know it from transmitting it to others.

What is the proper way to wear a mask?

- Before putting on a mask, clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
- Cover mouth and nose with mask and make sure there are no gaps between your face and the mask.
- Avoid touching the mask while using it; if you do, clean your hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
- Replace the mask with a new one as soon as it is damp and do not re-use single-use masks.
- To remove the mask: remove it from behind (do not touch the front of mask); discard immediately in a closed bin; clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.

Is the water safe to drink?

There is no evidence showing anyone has gotten COVID-19 through drinking water, recreational water or wastewater. The risk of COVID-19 transmission through water is expected to be low. However, drinking fountains remain covered because of possible contamination from folks using them, who may cough or leave residue on the fountain. Scam Warning

The Diocese of Jefferson City warns the public of what appears to be an ongoing phishing scam involving emails and texts purportedly from priests or parish/Chancery staff. This scam has hit many parishes across the United States. The email or text purports to be from a person the target knows, such as one's pastor, a parish staff member, the bishop or someone else from the Church. If the target responds to the fake email or text, the sender will follow up with a request for some sort of monetary assistance, often for gift cards or iTunes cards. It is truly unfortunate cyber criminals will attempt to exploit the generous nature of our community. Sending emails or texts asking for cash or gifts cards is not how priests, parishes or the Diocese of Jefferson City seeks financial assistance for our work. If you receive an email or text from a trusted church personnel asking for assistance, confirm by calling that person and do NOT respond to the email or text.

THE CORONAVIRUS: Protecting Your Finances

As communities around the world take action to prevent the spread of the coronavirus, or COVID-19, many people face financial uncertainty. As you make plans to protect you and your family financially during this time, consider the following steps you can take now.

- ◆ Focus your spending on NEEDS rather than WANTS: shelter, utilities, food, and transportation. Remember, this is temporary!
- ◆ Use a spending plan or budget to plan and track your income and expenses for the month.
- ◆ Get creative! Think about a temporary job or part-time work you could use to increase or supplement your income.
- ◆ Stay up to date with government benefits becoming available to assist those impacted such as unemployment benefits or paid sick leave.
- ◆ Worried about paying bills?, Contact your lenders or servicers and let them know about your situation. They may be able to offer you a number of options to help. Communication is key!
- ◆ Be aware of scams. Scammers look for opportunities to take advantage of those impacted by emergencies and disasters.
- ◆ Avoid panic shopping and making decisions out of fear. Buy only what you need and will actually use.
- ◆ Don't let a short-term crisis put you in long-term trouble—avoid taking on debt or cashing out investments.
- ◆ If possible, begin or continue to save to prepare for emergencies, future unemployment, or an ongoing crisis.
- ◆ Stuck at home? Avoid online shopping out of boredom, and find fun, free things to do at home.
- ◆ If possible, keep making minimum payments on all credit cards and debt to avoid damages to your credit.
- ◆ Check in with family and friends to see how you can help each other during this time – we are all in this together!

Relief Parents, St. Nicholas Academy

St. Nicholas Academy is a supportive living experience for boys from families that are under-resourced who want to give their sons every opportunity to succeed in school and life. St. Nick's partners with families and St. Peter Interparish School to provide this opportunity. St. Nick's is seeking Christian, married couples or single individuals who are willing to be part of a pool of relief parents. The role of relief parents is to care for the boys and home when the full-time house parents are off duty or away.

Typically, the full-time house parents are off duty every fourth weekend from 9:00 AM Friday through 7:00 PM Sunday. Relief parents, on a rotational schedule, fill in during this time. They may also be asked to be on a call list to help fill in when the house parents are on vacation and/or sick.

Relief parents receive an hourly wage, all legally mandated benefits and a compensation package that includes a private suite and all meals for the days on duty.

3. Todas las escuelas católicas suspenderán clases y continuarán su enseñanza en línea (online).
4. Se le invita a que continúe contribuyendo económicamente con su parroquia. El 86% del sostenimiento de la parroquia y personal depende de nuestra contribución. Puede continuar haciéndolo en línea.
