

Am I My Brother's Keeper? Yes, We Are!

Following the release of Bishop McKnight's August 21 Decree, the following **REVISED** protocols are now in effect for <u>all Masses</u> — Weddings and Funerals included — at St. Peter Parish until further notice.

Please know that we are carefully monitoring all directives and guidelines issued by state and local governments, as well as by the Diocese of Jefferson City, and will re-evaluate and adjust these protocols as warranted.

<u>HEALTH</u> – All the faithful are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and through November 27, 2020 provided the Lord's Day is kept holy by participating in the live-streamed Sunday Mass; praying with the readings of the Sunday Mass; and/or reciting the rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet. Those with underlying health issues are encouraged to avoid the risk of large public gatherings such as Sunday Mass. Please check your temperature and general well-being before coming to church. Those who are symptomatic for COVID-19 are not permitted to enter church. Pews and hard surfaces are sanitized after each Sunday Mass.

MASKS – Everyone must wear a mask upon entering and exiting church, and while moving in the Communion Procession to receive Holy Communion. Masks may be removed while seated in the pew, if so desired. If approaching to receive Holy Communion, please remove your mask just prior to receiving Our Lord, and moving it to cover your mouth and nose while returning to your pew. Please bring a personal mask with you. Ushers will have a limited supply for those who forget to bring a mask. Masks must be worn whenever adequate social distancing of at least six feet cannot be maintained in the pew.

<u>DISTANCE</u> – Everyone must maintain a distance of six feet from family groups and/or other individuals. Please follow the directions of our ushers and any signs or markings on pews and aisles

HYMNALS & MISSALETTES – All hymnals, missalettes and other paper materials are stored until after the pandemic protocols are lifted. We encourage you to bring your smartphone to reference prayers, songs and other devotions that are available through various mobile apps. Printed missalettes and weekly bulletins are available on the rectory porch for your personal use. If you pick up a missalette, please take it home with you. The song texts for Sunday Mass can be found on our parish Facebook page and parish website.

<u>HOLY COMMUNION</u> – Please follow the directions of the ushers and any floor marking to maintain the six-foot distance between the faithful in the line. Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand or on the tongue. For those wishing to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, a kneeler is also provided for your use. The Ministers of Holy Communion will sanitize their fingers after distributing Holy Communion on the tongue of each individual.

<u>TITHING</u> – Thank you for your continuing generosity in this challenging time. Please continue to make use of automatic bank drafts, mailed contributions, or placing envelopes in the slot on the rectory porch. There will also be a stationary basket placed in the center aisle during Sunday Masses so that you may leave your contribution there.

A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR

"Non sum dignus ut inters sub tectum meum"

Dear Friends,

Here's your weekly update regarding various things parochial. The repair to the stucco on three sides of Selinger Centre is continuing. The repair of stonework and the water sealing of the masonry should be completed shortly. Construction of the scaffolding on the nave of church was completed this week. Now the erection of the tower scaffolding will continue for the next couple of weeks. This phase will continue to temporarily impact the accessibility to certain church and chapel entrances from time to time. Please be patient and observe the signage, caution tape and safety fencing. The alley between Selinger Centre and church will remain closed for the next number of months.

Many thanks to all of you who participated in the Better Together small group meetings a number of months ago. Your prayerful reflections and conversation were helpful not only for the ongoing formation of a new Diocese Pastoral Plan, but also in identifying particular needs (as well as strengths) within our own parish. Subsequent to those meetings, I asked an ad hoc committee of parishioners to collate and organize the various responses that were submitted. After careful reading during a number of meetings, that committee submitted their findings to me. Three overarching needs for St. Peter Parish were identified and those have been presented to the Parish Pastoral Council as foundational goals for our efforts going forward. The three goals are:

- 1.) Improve communication within and outside of the parish and school. (Greater communication using all available means to promote, inform and motivate parishioners).
- 2.) Expand faith formation and catechetical opportunities for adult parishioners. (More opportunities for the faithful to deepen and expand their appreciation and practice of the faith).
- 3.) Develop a greater sense of the mission of our parish and school. (Closer collaboration between the school, parish and all parish organizations in pursuing common goals and the demands of the Gospel).

 In the coming weeks, I will further expand on how all of us can

work together to achieve these goals.

Finally, per the request of some of you after Mass, these are the Subjects for Daily Meditation that I mentioned in a recent Sunday homily:

Remember, Christian soul, that you have this day and every day of your life: God to glorify, Jesus to imitate, the angels and saints to invoke, a soul to save, a body to mortify, sins to expiate, virtues to acquire, hell to avoid, heaven to gain, eternity to prepare for, time to profit by, neighbors to edify, the world to despise. devils to combat, passions to subdue, death perhaps to suffer and Judgment to undergo.

Alice Kuehn's Nurse Notes

Hand-Washing Review. Now that school has started, and there are after school snacks, and many afternoon and evening activities with treats, it helps to review good handwashing technique.

Having clean hands is one of the most important steps we can take to avoid getting sick and spreading germs to others and is a critical part of dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic as well as an important part of preventing spread of the flu - flu season is coming soon. Many other diseases and conditions are also spread by not washing hands correctly. Therefore, here is a reminder once again: when washing hands, wet them with clean, running water (warm or cold) and apply soap. Rub your hands together to make a lather and scrub them well; be sure to scrub the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails. Continue rubbing your hands for at least 20 seconds. Need a timer? Pray the Lord's Prayer twice. If soap and water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. These hand sanitizers can quickly reduce the number of germs on hands in some situations, but do not eliminate all types of germs. Hand sanitizers are also not effective when hands are visibly dirty. To use hand sanitizers correctly, apply the product to the palm of one hand, rub your hands together and then rub the product over all surfaces of your hands and fingers until your hands are dry. Note: There are hand sanitizers at all the entrances of the church for parishioner use, in the Parish Life Center and in the school.
