WEDDING INFORMATION - The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the priest. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and <u>at least</u> six months prior to the wedding. Any Catholic being married should be confirmed. A pre-marital assessment (FOCCUS) and a Pre-Cana Class or Engaged Encounter must be taken.

Jefferson City Pre-Cana: Pre-Cana is one component of the marriage preparation option available to couples considering marriage within the Catholic Church.

Catholic Engaged Encounter is an in-depth, private, personal, marriage preparation experience within the context of Catholic faith and values. The registration form, as well as Engaged Encounter weekend information, is available on our diocesan website, www.diojeffcity.org, Our Church, Life & Marriage, Engaged Encounter.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM - Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class **prior to** your child's birth.

Sessions are held the first Tuesday for first-time parents and the third Tuesday for "experienced" parents the months of: **February, May, August & November**. Contact the parish office to sign up.

CONFIRMATION - Confirmation deepens our baptismal life that calls us to be missionary witnesses of Jesus Christ in our families, neighborhoods, society, and the world.

The primary goal of this program is to prepare you for the Sacrament of Confirmation. If you are seeking Confirmation, please talk to the priest by contacting the parish office at 573-636-8159.

RCIA - St. Peter Parish invites you to take a deeper look at how Christ as a member of the Catholic Church is in your best eternal interest. You're invited, along with others who are searching, to a series of "Inquiry" meetings - with no strings attached - to see what it means to be a part of the Catholic Church, what we believe and how we try to faithfully live it together, becoming what God, in His goodness, intends. RCIA is a process, not a program or a course in adult religious education. It is about change of heart or conversion. It takes time for us to be aware of God working in our lives and for us to be open enough to listen to God speaking in our hearts. Classes start in September. Here we are, beginning a New Year. If you are one to make resolutions, keep them simple and attainable. Now is the time to take stock of your mental and physical health.

The third week of January is *Watch your Weight Week* – perhaps resolve to look closely at your daily diet and exercise routine or non-routine and work to make them a healthier part of your life. There are about 800,000 strokes each year in the United States and many of us have risk factors that could lead to strokes. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention notes that: "High blood pressure, high cholesterol and smoking are key risk factors for stroke. About half of Americans have at least one of these three risk factors." Other risk factors include being overweight, being physically inactive, and drinking too much alcohol. You can reduce these risks.

Your New Year's resolutions could perhaps include a resolve to look closely at your daily diet and exercise <u>routine or non-routine</u> and work to make them a healthier part of your life.
