WEDDING INFORMATION - The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the priest. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least six months prior to the wedding. Any Catholic being married should be confirmed. A pre-marital assessment (FOCCUS) and a Pre-Cana Class or Engaged Encounter must be taken.

Jefferson City Pre-Cana: Pre-Cana is one component of the marriage preparation option available to couples considering marriage within the Catholic Church.

Catholic Engaged Encounter is an in-depth, private, personal, marriage preparation experience within the context of Catholic faith and values. Catholic Engaged Encounter is a weekend retreat away with other engaged couples with plenty of time alone together to dialogue honestly and intensively about their prospective lives together.

The registration form, as well as Engaged Encounter weekend information, is available on our diocesan website, www.diojeffcity.org, Our Church, Life & Marriage, Engaged Encounter. The registration form can be found on our site. The cost for the weekend is \$100 per couple. A \$25 deposit made payable to Engaged Encounter is required and to be included with the registration form. The weekends are held at St. Pius X in Moberly.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM - Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class **prior to** your child's birth.



Spring Cleaning

As we move from February and head into March, you might already be thinking of spring-cleaning – maybe you already did some for a New Year's resolution! One important place to visit and tidy up is the medicine cabinet/closet. If your medicine cabinet is full of expired drugs or medications you no longer use, how should you dispose of them?

Some communities host a drug "take back" program, and currently in Jefferson City, the 24-hour Walgreens on Missouri Blvd. now has a "deposit box" located in the pharmacy area for disposing of outdated prescription and over-the-counter drugs. In addition, there is now one at Capital Region Medical Center Physicians building, 2nd floor next to gift shop. The U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) offers a National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day twice a year (spring and fall), which aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse and medications. The spring 2020 collection date is Saturday, April 25, 10am-2pm. List of local collection sites will be released on April 1 and will be included in an April bulletin. If you wish to dispose of your medications before then, and the Walgreen's "deposit box" is locked (when it is filled) here are guidelines released by the DEA to assist you to safely dispose of them yourself:

<u>First, do not flush medications</u> as they can have a negative effect on septic systems and wastewater treatment plants. In addition, some pharmaceuticals get released in nearby lakes, rivers or groundwater with a possible negative effect on the environment and wildlife.

<u>Solid medications</u>: remove from pill bottle and put into a hard plastic container such as a bleach or laundry detergent bottle. Add a small amount of Coca-Cola. Pepsi-Cola or Dr. Pepper to dissolve the meds. Then add thickening like cat litter, flour or coffee grounds. Recap and seal container with duct tape and place in the trash just before pickup.

<u>Blister packs</u> (foil-wrapped pills and patches): Keep in original packaging, wrap pack with duct tape, place in hard plastic container, seal and place in the trash just before pickup. <u>Liquid medications</u>: Pour contents into bleach or detergent bottle, add thickening such as cat litter, flour or coffee grounds. Recap and seal with duct tape and place in the trash just before pick-up.
