## Sacramental Life

**WEDDING INFORMATION** - *The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the priest.* You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled **after approval** by the priest and **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Any Catholic being married should be confirmed. A pre-marital assessment (FOCCUS) and a Pre-Caná Class or Engaged Encounter must be taken.

**Jefferson City Pre-Caná:** Pre-Caná is one component of the marriage preparation option available to couples considering marriage within the Catholic Church.

**Catholic Engaged Encounter** is an in-depth, private, personal, marriage preparation experience within the context of Catholic faith and values. Catholic Engaged Encounter is a weekend retreat away with other engaged couples with plenty of time alone together to dialogue honestly and intensively about their prospective lives together.

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM** - Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class **prior to** your child's birth.

**February, May, August & November**

Sunday afternoon Baptisms will be held the 2nd Sunday of every other month. **Remaining 2019 Community Baptism Dates:** **October 13th, December 8th**

**CONFIRMATION** - Confirmation deepens our baptismal life that calls us to be missionary witnesses of Jesus Christ in our families, neighborhoods, society, and the world.... We receive the message of faith in a deeper and more intensive manner with great emphasis given to the person of Jesus Christ, who asked the Father to give the Holy Spirit to the Church for building up the community in loving service.

The primary goal of this program is to prepare you for the Sacrament of Confirmation. If you are seeking Confirmation, please talk to the priest or contact the office.

**RCIA** - St. Peter Parish invites you to take a deeper look at how Christ as a member of the Catholic Church is in your best eternal interest. You're invited, along with others who are searching, to a series of "Inquiry" meetings - with no strings attached - to see what it means to be a part of the Catholic Church, what we believe and how we try to faithfully live it together, becoming what God, in His goodness, intends. RCIA is a process, not a program or a course in adult religious education. It is about change of heart or conversion. It takes time for us to be aware of God working in our lives and for us to be open enough to listen to God speaking in our hearts. 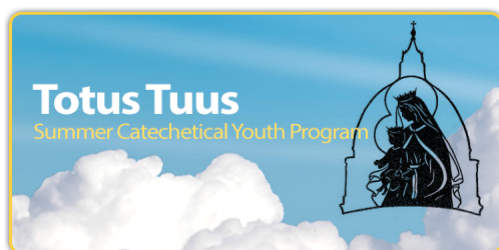

#### Alice Kuehn's Nurse Notes

##### Spring Cleaning

As we move from February and head into March, you might already be thinking of spring-cleaning – maybe you already did some for a New Year's resolution! One important place to visit and tidy up is the medicine cabinet/closet. If your medicine cabinet is full of expired drugs or medications you no longer use, how should you dispose of them?

Some communities host a drug "take back" program, and currently in Jefferson City, the 24-hour Walgreens on Missouri Blvd. now has a "deposit box" located in the pharmacy area for disposing of outdated prescription and over-the-counter drugs. In addition, there is now one at Capital Region Medical Center Physicians building, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor next to gift shop. The U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) offers a National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day twice a year (spring and fall), which aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse and medications. The spring 2020 collection date is Saturday, April 25, 10am-2pm. List of local collection sites will be released on April 1 and will be included in an April bulletin. If you wish to dispose of your medications before then, and the Walgreen's "deposit box" is locked (when it is filled) here are guidelines released by the DEA to assist you to safely dispose of them yourself:

First, do not flush medications as they can have a negative effect on septic systems and wastewater treatment plants. In addition, some pharmaceuticals get released in nearby lakes, rivers or groundwater with a possible negative effect on the environment and wildlife.

Solid medications: remove from pill bottle and put into a hard plastic container such as a bleach or laundry detergent bottle. Add a small amount of Coca-Cola, Pepsi-Cola or Dr. Pepper to dissolve the meds. Then add thickening like cat litter, flour or coffee grounds. Recap and seal container with duct tape and place in the trash just before pickup.

Blister packs (foil-wrapped pills and patches): Keep in original packaging, wrap pack with duct tape, place in hard plastic container, seal and place in the trash just before pickup.

Liquid medications: Pour contents into bleach or detergent bottle, add thickening such as cat litter, flour or coffee grounds. Recap and seal with duct tape and place in the trash just before pick-up.
