

WEEKEND MASS COUNT



WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the **diojeffcity.org** webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated. All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.

IMPORTANT NOTICE — PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Purpose

As described in Church Law, the Parish Pastoral Council is a structure of consultation and consensus. It is a planning council, not a coordinating council. It is a consultative planning group aiding the Pastor in the decision-making process. It is the function of the Parish Pastoral Council to "investigate everything pertaining to pastoral activities, to weigh them carefully, and to set forth practical conclusions concerning them so as to encourage conformity of the life and actions of the People of God with the Gospel" (Motu Proprio, Ecclesiae Sanctae). Specifically, the Parish Pastoral Council is called upon to aid the pastor and every member of our parish to further the mission of Christ among us, in a coordinated and unified manner.

Membership

The St. Peter Parish Pastoral Council is composed of ten parishioners that serve three year terms. The terms shall be staggered so that one third of the lay member positions are brought up for election each year.

Nominations

This year there are four positions open on the St. Peter Parish Pastoral Council. These four positions will serve from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2027. The Council meets a minimum of six times and up to eight times a year depending upon the needs of the Parish. Mrs. Jane Schneider's Classroom Update

Mrs. Schneider's Room has had quite an exciting year in Writing. In September and October, they carved a pumpkin, decorated it, and wrote a descriptive paper about it. They also participated in a poetry contest for the Bittersweet Garden Club in Jefferson City. Out of 108 participants, three students in VLC won first place in their division: Brody Bax, 5th Grade; Larissa Rivera, 6th Grade; and Anneliese Careaga, 8th Grade. They also made a quilt about each one of their poems.

In November and December, they researched a saint and learned about the Chapel at St. Peter Catholic Church. The students wrote a letter in the form of a prayer to their saint. Then, they lit a candle and read their letters as a prayer in the chapel. In January and February, they wrote a creative story of their choice. The story included exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution. They learned that everyday experiences fall into each of these categories.

In March, they are currently working on current events and learning about the news that affects them and the world. They picked an AI (artificial intelligence) topic to write opinion papers on. We also talked about St. Patrick and Leprechauns for St. Patrick's Day. It has been a great year, with more to come!




