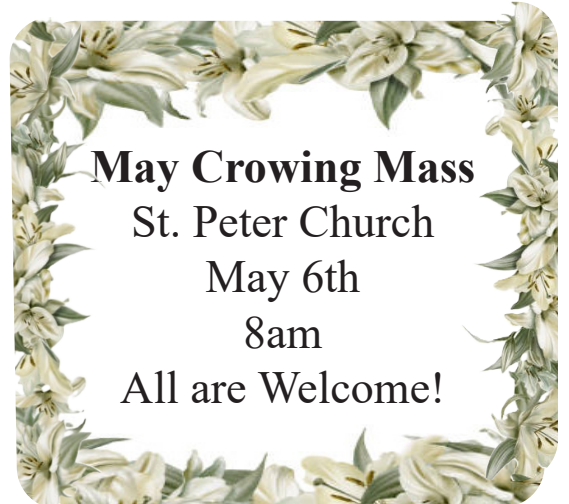

# NURSES NOTES



## Spotlighted Column Topics: *physical activity recommendations, physical wellness dimension*

As daylight hours continue to lengthen and the beautiful-weather days outnumber the rough-weather days, many of us experience renewed energy and motivation, and perhaps increased interest in spending time outdoors. Because of this, it seems a perfect topic for this week's bulletin is *physical activity*. Just like proper nutrition, the benefits of exercise / physical activity on our overall health can not be overemphasized!

Only about 20% of us achieve the recommended amount of physical activity to maintain good health (AHA, 2024). When the Office of Disease Prevention and Health Promotion (within the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services) published the current *Physical Activity Guidelines for Americans* (2<sup>nd</sup> edition) in 2018, the 3 overarching messages to adults were meaningful and uplifting:

~ **Move more, sit less!**

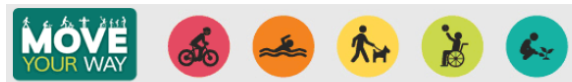
~ **Some physical activity is better than none.**

~ **Sitting less & doing any amount of moderate-to-vigorous physical activity has health benefits.**

While the actual total time/minute recommendations for adults and children did not change, an exciting and noteworthy update was the removal of only 10-minute exercise episodes counting toward the weekly goal. This change was based on research verifying that "any amount of physical activity has some health benefits" and these benefits begin immediately; additionally, this update "encourages Americans to move more frequently throughout the day as we work toward meeting the guidelines" (ODPHP, n.d.).

Here are the physical activity recommendations by age group for attaining substantial health benefits (U.S. DHHS, 2018):

- ✓ **Ages 3-5** should be physically active throughout the day with a variety of activity types.
- ✓ **Ages 6-17** should do at least 60 minutes (1 hour) of moderate-to-vigorous physical activity daily, including aerobic, muscle-strengthening, & bone-strengthening activities.
- ✓ **Adults** should fit in at least **150 minutes (2.5 hours) per week of moderate-intensity activity, or at least 75 minutes per week of vigorous activity, or a combination of both.** Ideally activity should be spread throughout the week. Muscle-strengthening activities should be performed on 2 or more days involving all major muscle groups.



This publication also includes key guidelines for specific groups: Older Adults, Women during Pregnancy & Postpartum, and Adults with Chronic Health Conditions & Adults with Disabilities; as well as outlines guidelines to ensure safety during physical activity.

## Whistleblower Hotline

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns, or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the **diojeffcity.org** webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated.

All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.
