

VIGIL OPPOSING STATE EXECUTION

Catholic teaching strongly opposes the use of the death penalty because it disregards the sanctity and dignity of human life. Brian Dorsey is scheduled to be executed on April 9. The Missouri Catholic Conference will host a respectful protest on Tuesday, April 9, at noon outside the governor's office (Room 216, State Capitol Building, Jefferson City) to witness against the execution. WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns or any other issues. The hotline number is: 573-635-0386. Information about the hotline is available at the top of the diojeffcity.org webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated. All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.

The Moreau River and its tributaries aer a central feature of Mid- Missouri, flowing through communities including Jefferson City, Russellville, Lohman, Enon, Honey Creek, Brazito, Hickory Hill, and California. The waters pass tall bluffs, flow under highways, and nourish the area's rich farmland, and, from them, fascinating stories emerge. That of a former slave who lived to the impressive age of 113, a Lutheran congregation that hosted a Wild West lawman. Jeremy Amick, author of *Moments on the Moreau* and its companion compilation, *Hidden History of Cole County*, shares these and more historical stories linking the Moreau River to the people that have made their homes along its banks.







