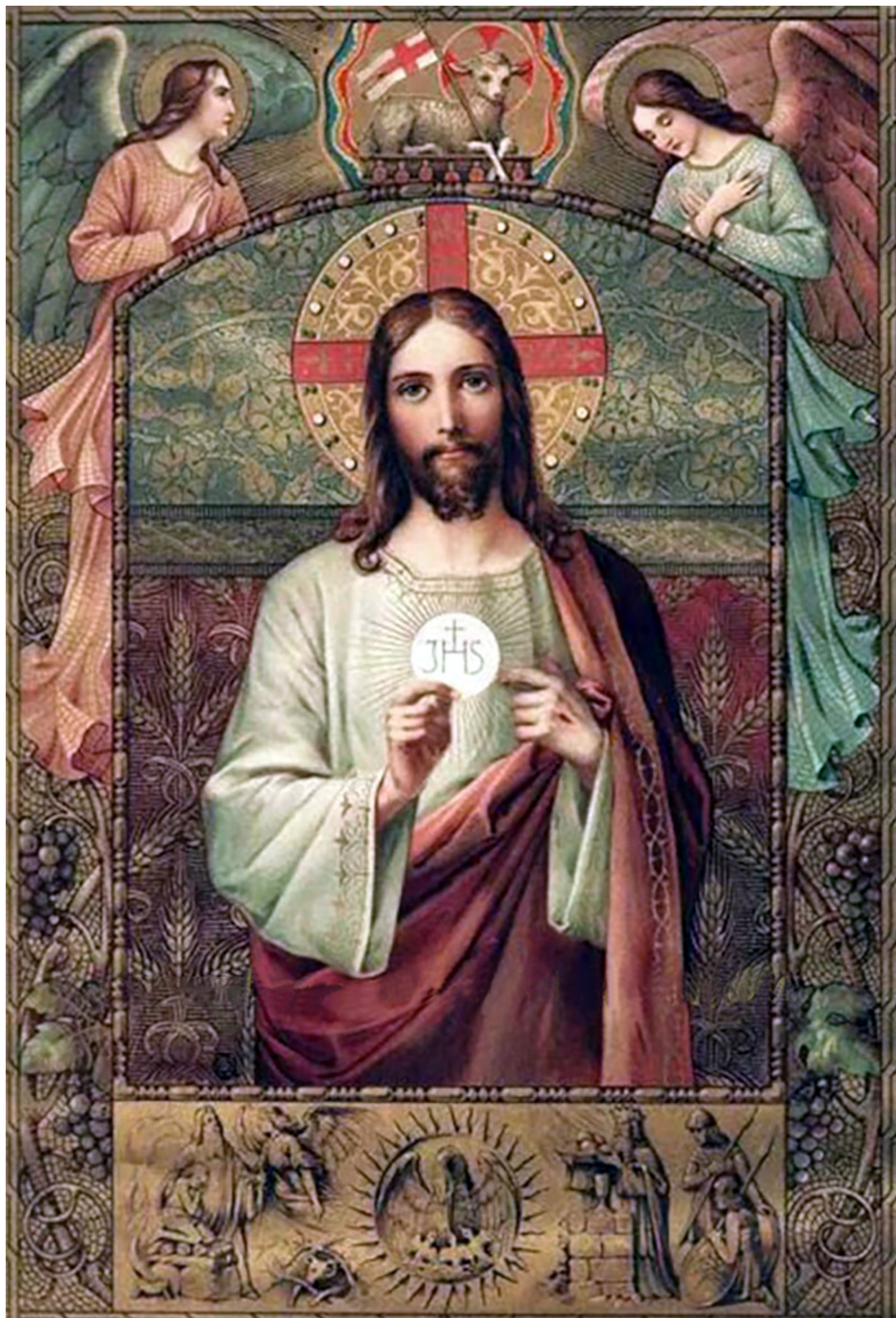

A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR...

Dear friends in Christ,

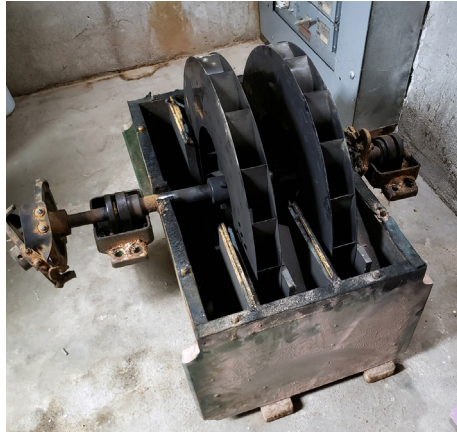
First off, I want to let you know that the interior work in church continues with vigor and intensity. Just as there was a coordinated “dance” between three or more contractors or tradesmen at any one time for the exterior restoration work of church; that same dynamic continues on with the interior work.

For example, during the past week, before the installation of the new floor, the original 1883 tongue and groove pine flooring was thoroughly vacuumed and inspected for squeaks and loose boards by yours truly. Steven Duncan and his company added hundreds of fasteners to firm up the subflooring and do preparatory framing for drywall installation in the new confessionals. Larry Wiskirchen, of our parish maintenance staff, installed new wiring and exhaust fan ducting for the confessionals and the front restroom. A crew from Richardet Floor Covering began laying the 3/8” underlayment, vapor barrier, and the oak hardwood in the nave. Angela Hull has been doing baseboard trim removal, sanding and painting. Steve’s Pest Control confirmed that damage to baseboards in the narthex was no longer an active infestation of powderpost beetles. And finally, Rainbow Painting began preparations for the repair of some plaster and paint in one of the bays on the south side of church nearest the Great division of the pipe organ which had been suffering from water penetration with the previous roof and guttering.

Speaking of pipe organs, perhaps you are aware of the basic principles of how pipe organs work? For every one of the 61 notes on a modern organ keyboard (or the 32 keys on the pedal board), there is a corresponding pipe of varying length in each rank (sets of pipes). When a stop is drawn for a particular rank, pressurized wind is allowed to flow from the windchest into the bottom of a pipe when a particular key, or multiple keys are played. The sound of the tone produced is determined by the shape and formation of the pipes. The smaller the pipe, the higher the pitch; the larger the pipe length, the lower the pitch...provided

that there’s a steady wind supply to the bellows (the “lungs”) of the pipe organ.

Recently, a re-discovery was made here at St. Peter Church. Under the confessional on the St. Joseph side sat an organ blower from the Kinetic Engineering Company of



Philadelphia, PA. It’s name plate indicates patents from 1907 and scribbles on the paper instruction sheet still affixed to the front of the beautiful green blower box indicate that it had been regularly oiled from October, 1914 until at least August, 1921. This blower would have been lowered through the church floorboards at some point after 1907 in order to provide wind to the J.G. Pfeffer pipe organ installed in the loft in 1900.

The Kinetic organ blower was removed from it’s partially buried and forgotten place under church and will eventually have a more suitable spot for public display and examination. Next time, we’ll explore how this organ blower was powered and why it was situated where it was. In the mean time, if anyone knows when public water and electricity was made available to St. Peter Church and School, please let me know.

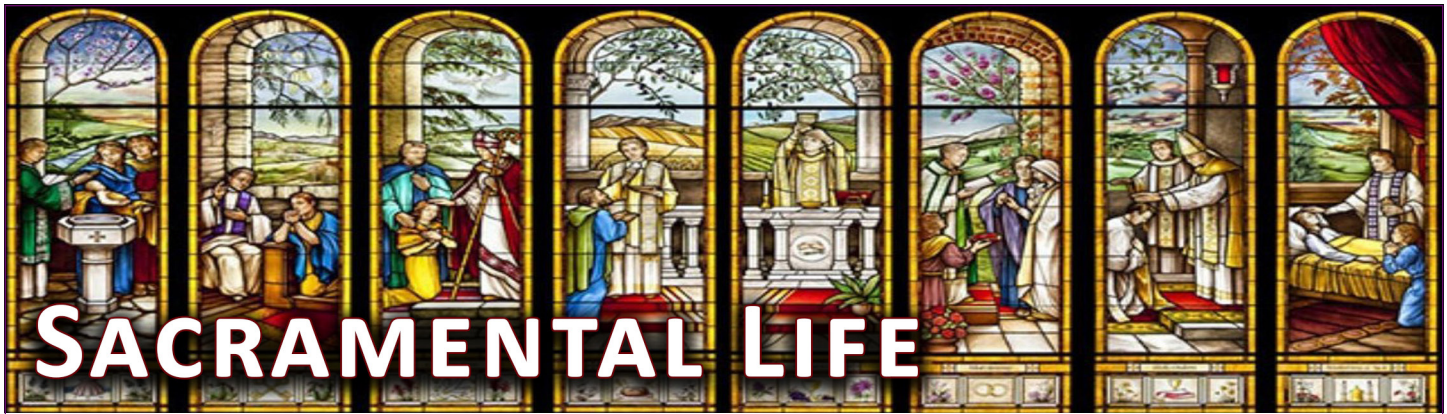
Exposition will begin each day, Monday through Friday, after the 8:00 am Mass and will continue until 8:00 pm that evening. Daily Mass will be celebrated upstairs in the church.

To facilitate sign up and scheduling we are using a software program called Adoration Pro. It is like the Ministry scheduling program St. Peter’s uses for liturgical ministries and is very simple to use.

1. Press the Weekly Commitment button.
2. That will take you to the schedule where you can select an hour. We need at least two adorers, (two different households) for each hour, so even if someone’s name is next to an hour you can still sign up for that hour if the sign up button is present.
3. When you press the Sign up button for a specific hour/day that will take you to a page where you will enter your personal information. Don’t forget to press the signup button at the bottom of that page.
4. An email will be sent to you confirming your weekly commitment. as well as contact information and information about requesting a sub.
5. You may be asked if you would like to serve as a sub, or you can sign up to be a sub on the original sign in page. You will receive an email confirming you have signed up and you can indicate your hours of availability.
6. When we begin Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in September you will receive a weekly text/email reminder the day before your hour of adoration.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Uniform items are provided by vendors selected by St. Peter School. All shirts, sweatshirts, and sweaters will have the St. Peter School logo embroidered on the left chest and are purchased through St. Peter School. Microfleece half-zip pullovers and girls jumpers are available through Land's

End website ONLY accessible through the St. Peter website.

On "Spirit Wear Days" students may wear any St. Peter School attire that contains the "Keys to the Kingdom" with dress code bottoms. ALL items with the "Keys to the Kingdom" must be purchased through the school or created with administrative approval. "Spirit Wear Days" are Fridays and special occasions throughout the school year.

Our school logo is changing this year, but uniforms with the old logo are still acceptable uniform attire. As we fill orders old logo shirts will go out first. The Church logo has also been updated and tops are available to purchase, however those tops are not considered school uniform attire.

Several of you have contacted us asking if you can still order uniforms. Yes you can still order but there is no guarantee that those orders will be filled by the first day of school. We do keep extra inventory in stock and will make accommodations as best as we can. Orders received after the June 25th deadline will go out first come first serve. Send in a completed order form with payment to the school office as soon as possible. You can find the order form on our school website.

ENROLLMENT AND SCHOOL PAYMENTS

By now you should have completed your child's enrollment in FACTS. St. Peter School will fill any openings for grades now that registration is closed.

You will not be making any school payments until August 2021. Payments will be collected through FACTS online ONLY. FACTS will send an email letting you know when you are to make your payment.

Our first day of school will be Wednesday, August 18, 2021. The 2021-2022 Tentative Calendar is available on our website. Any changes made to this calendar will be updated through the newsletter and always accessible on our St. Peter webpage.

Open House will be Monday, August 16th from 4:00-6:00 PM. Watch the newsletter for more Open House details. The School Supply List 2021/22 is also posted on our webpage.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Under Missouri law, students' health records must be up-to-date in order to attend school. There is a four-day grace period to finish obtaining immunizations once school has started, but it would be best to get immunizations during the summer. If you have questions as to what shots your child might need, go

to MO Dept. of Health and Senior Services here. If a student has had a recent immunization, please send the most current shot record to the school office.

VIRTUS TRAINING

The Diocese has updated its Safe Environment requirements for schools, beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. All parents will be required to take the Safe Environment training and be cleared to volunteer in order for their children to register and attend school. This policy will not impact all of our parents – many are already trained and able to volunteer freely in our schools.
