

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.





ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES

AUGUST IS HOT -KEEP YOURSELF SAFE

Here are some tips to prevent heat-related illness and injuries during August "Dog Days:"

- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing, a hat and sunscreen
- Drink plenty of water even if you don't feel thirsty
- Pace yourself
- · Sit down and rest occasionally
- Go inside to cool off if needed
- If you start feeling signs of heat-related illness: Tired, weak, dizzy, headache, fainting, heavy sweating, cold, pale and clammy skin, a fast weak pulse, nausea, or muscle cramps – Go to a "cooling station" and seek first aid. These are signs of "heat exhaustion"

If you see someone who has some of the above symptoms but instead has a strong pulse, hot dry skin (not sweaty), seems confused, has a high body temperature or "passes out" rush them to the emergency room as they may be developing "heat stroke."

If you are wearing a cloth face covering as safety against COVID-19, and feel you are overheating or having trouble breathing, put yourself 6 feet from others and remove the face covering. Go to a "cooling station" and seek First Aid if still feeling ill.

Have a wonderful, safe and blessed time during this beginning of the end of summer!




