FIRST RECONCILIATION/HOLY COMMUNION, AND CONFIRMATION

HOLY MATRIMONY

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Resolution

Whereas, the Diocese of Jefferson City proudly wishes to recognize Saint Peter Church, Jefferson City, Missouri, which is celebrating its Anniversary of Dedication on August 12, 2023; and

Whereas, in 1882 and 1883, Monsignor Otto J. Hoog, together with many local families, most notably the Binder and Dulle households, were instrumental in constructing this third gothic church; and

Whereas, on February 2, 1883, Monsignor Hoog celebrated the First Mass in the newly finished church; and

Whereas, one hundred forty years ago, on August 12, 1883, Coadjutor-Archbishop Patrick J. Ryan of St. Louis solemnly dedicated Saint Peter Church; and

Whereas, Saint Peter Church was the first cathedral of the diocese from August 24, 1956 until the opening of the new Cathedral of St. Joseph on December 25, 1968; and

Whereas, Father Jeremy A. Secrist, Pastor of Saint Peter Church, and parishioners have been most dedicated to keeping this house of God both beautiful and worthy of its sacred nature while holding true to its significance to the downtown community;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that I, Bishop W. Shawn McKnight, join in extending our most heartfelt congratulations to all the clergy and laity on this special anniversary event and declare that Saint Peter's Church shall now be known as the "Proto-Cathedral of St. Peter" in the Diocese of Jefferson City; and

Be it further resolved that our Chancellor prepare a copy of this resolution in recognition of this title and file it accordingly in the official archives.

ST. PETER CHURCH NOW NAMED PROTO-CATHEDRAL OF ST. PETER

Bishop W. Shawn McKnight issued a resolution on Thursday, August 10, 2023 declaring that St. Peter Church would now be known as the Proto-Cathedral of St. Peter.

"Proto" is Greek for "first" or "original."

Completed and dedicated in 1883, St. Peter Proto-Cathedral served as the cathedral from the Jefferson City diocese's founding in 1956 until the completion of the Cathedral of St. Joseph in 1968.

The third church for what was once the Capital City's only parish was built in 1882-1883, when Monsignor Otto Hoog was pastor, with substantial help from the Bender and Dulle families.

Msgr. Hoog offered the first Mass in the Church on February 2, 1883.

Coadjutor Archbishop Patrick J. Ryan of St. Louis, who later became archbishop of Philadelphia, solemnly dedicated the church August 12, 1883.

LITTLE SAINTS CARE PROGRAM

Recognizing the need to provide assistance to parents with younger children on Sunday mornings, on September 3, St. Peter will begin offering a care program during the 9:00 am Sunday Mass for children ages 2-5. The program will be held in the current Preschool building. Parents and grandparents will be invited to bring their little ones to the Preschool building starting at 8:45 am and children will be picked up immediately after the 9:00 am Sunday Mass.

Children will learn about God's love, pray together, play, and have fun in a safe and creative environment. All Little Saints Care Program volunteers will undergo a screening interview, have a criminal background check, read and sign the Code of Conduct, and be certified in "Protecting God's Children," the diocesan safe environment training program.
