St. Monica is the patron saint of mothers, wives and victims of abuse.

She is the mother of Perpetua and Navigius who entered the religious life, and Augustine who lead a hedonistic lifestyle, left the Christian faith and became a Manichaean.

St. Monica prayed continually for Augustine. She went to a bishop, who told her, "the child of those tears shall never perish."

At the age of 31, Augustine converted back to Christianity. He became a theologian, philosopher and Bishop of Hippo. He is a Doctor of the Church and was canonized in 1298 by Pope Boniface VIII.

St. Augustine credited St. Monica's prayers with bringing him back to the Catholic faith.

### **LADIES SODALITY**




# CURSILLO PILGRIMAGE TO PERRYVILLE




