MASS TO COMMEMORATE THE THE DEDICATION OF ST. PETER CHURCH

A special celebration of the Mass will be held on Thursday, **August 12, 2021 at 6:00 pm** in the Selinger Chapel to commemorate the dedication of St. Peter Church. Fr. Secrist will be the celebrant.

Following the 6:00 pm Mass, will be a presentation at 7:00 pm, on the history of St. Peter Church in relationship to the State Capitol. The speaker will be Gary Kremer, Executive Director of the State Historical Society of Missouri. A fifth-generation Missourian, Gary R. Kremer earned his PhD from American University in Washington, DC. Mr. Kremer has written, coauthored, and coedited 12 books. Previously, Mr. Kremer taught history at Lincoln University in Jefferson City (1972-1987) and William Woods University in Fulton (1991-2004). He also served as the state archivist of Missouri from 1987 to 1991. He has been SHSMO's executive director since 2004.

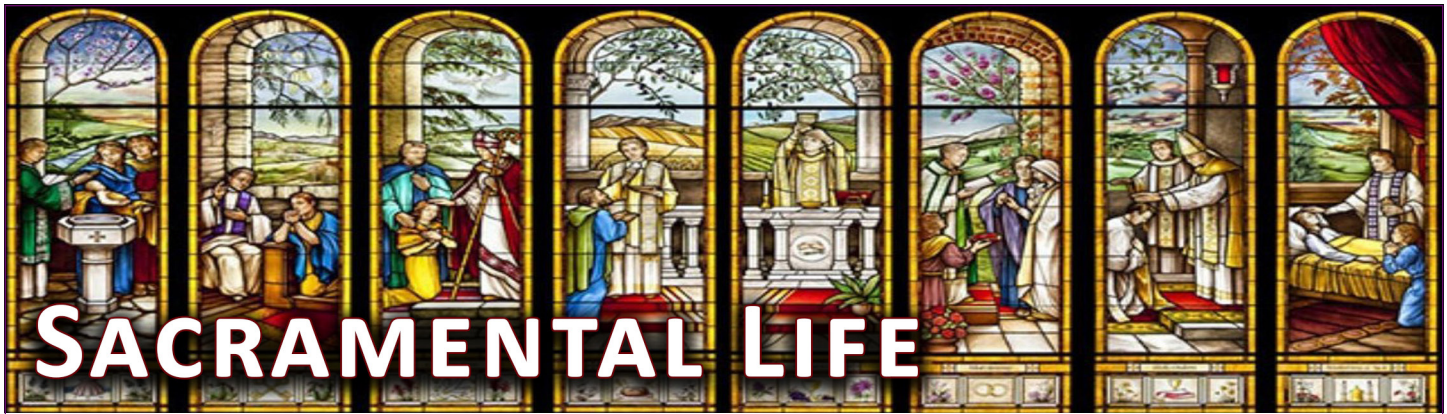
CURSILLO PILGRIMAGE TO PERRYVILLE

Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Uniform items are provided by vendors selected by St. Peter School. All shirts, sweatshirts, and sweaters will have the St. Peter School logo embroidered on the left chest and are purchased through St. Peter School. Microfleece half-zip pullovers and girls jumpers are available through Land's

End website ONLY accessible through the St. Peter website.

On "Spirit Wear Days" students may wear any St. Peter School attire that contains the "Keys to the Kingdom" with dress code bottoms. ALL items with the "Keys to the Kingdom" must be purchased through the school or created with administrative approval. "Spirit Wear Days" are Fridays and special occasions throughout the school year.

Our school logo is changing this year, but uniforms with the old logo are still acceptable uniform attire. As we fill orders old logo shirts will go out first. The Church logo has also been updated and tops are available to purchase, however those tops are not considered school uniform attire.

Several of you have contacted us asking if you can still order uniforms. Yes you can still order but there is no guarantee that those orders will be filled by the first day of school. We do keep extra inventory in stock and will make accommodations as best as we can. Orders received after the June 25th deadline will go out first come first serve. Send in a completed order form with payment to the school office as soon as possible. You can find the order form on our school website.

ENROLLMENT AND SCHOOL PAYMENTS

By now you should have completed your child's enrollment in FACTS. St. Peter School will fill any openings for grades now that registration is closed.

You will not be making any school payments until August 2021. Payments will be collected through FACTS online ONLY. FACTS will send an email letting you know when you are to make your payment.

Our first day of school will be Wednesday, August 18, 2021. The 2021-2022 Tentative Calendar is available on our website. Any changes made to this calendar will be updated through the newsletter and always accessible on our St. Peter webpage.

Open House will be Monday, August 16th from 4:00-6:00 PM. Watch the newsletter for more Open House details. The School Supply List 2021/22 is also posted on our webpage.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Under Missouri law, students' health records must be up-to-date in order to attend school. There is a four-day grace period to finish obtaining immunizations once school has started, but it would be best to get immunizations during the summer. If you have questions as to what shots your child might need, go

to MO Dept. of Health and Senior Services here. If a student has had a recent immunization, please send the most current shot record to the school office.

VIRTUS TRAINING

The Diocese has updated its Safe Environment requirements for schools, beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. All parents will be required to take the Safe Environment training and be cleared to volunteer in order for their children to register and attend school. This policy will not impact all of our parents – many are already trained and able to volunteer freely in our schools. ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

AUGUST GETS HOT –ENJOY THE 175TH ANNIVERSARY PARTY AND KEEP YOURSELF SAFE AS WELL

While enjoying the parish 175th anniversary, come prepared to deal with the August heat and the crowds. To help keep us safe during the festivities, the parish is planning to have a First Aid station in the Hospitality room (lower level of the Selinger Centre). Access will only be through the Alley entrance. This will also serve as a "cooling center." There will also be an ambulance on site as a precaution. In addition, there will be PortaPotties on site for your convenience.

Here are some tips to prevent heat-related illness and injuries during the party:

- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing, a hat and sunscreen
- Drink plenty of water even if you don't feel thirsty
- Pace yourself
- Sit down and rest occasionally
- Go to Hospitality Room to cool off if

needed

- If you start feeling signs of heat-related illness: Tired, weak, dizzy, headache, fainting, heavy sweating, cold, pale and clammy skin, fast, weak pulse, nausea, or muscle cramps – Go to a "cooling station" and seek first aid. These are signs of *heat exhaustion*
 - If you see someone who has some of the above symptoms but instead has a strong pulse, hot dry skin (not sweaty), seems confused, has a high body temperature or "passes out" rush them to the ambulance station as they may be developing *heat stroke*.
 - If you are wearing a cloth face covering as safety against COVID-19, and feel you are overheating or having trouble breathing, put yourself 6 feet from others and remove the face covering. Go to the "cooling station" and seek First Aid if still feeling ill.
- Have a wonderful, safe and blessed time at our 175th anniversary party!!
