Am I My Brother's Keeper? Yes, We Are!

Following the release of Bishop McKnight's August 21 Decree, the following **REVISED** protocols are now in effect for all Masses — Weddings and Funerals included — at St. Peter Parish until further notice.

Please know that we are carefully monitoring all directives and guidelines issued by state and local governments, as well as by the Diocese of Jefferson City, and will re-evaluate and adjust these protocols as warranted.

HEALTH — All the faithful are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and through November 27, 2020 provided the Lord's Day is kept holy by participating in the live-streamed Sunday Mass; praying with the readings of the Sunday Mass; and/or reciting the rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet. Those with underlying health issues are encouraged to avoid the risk of large public gatherings such as Sunday Mass. Please check your temperature and general well-being before coming to church. Those who are symptomatic for COVID-19 are not permitted to enter church. Pews and hard surfaces are sanitized after each Sunday Mass.

MASKS — Everyone must wear a mask upon entering and exiting church, and while moving in the Communion Procession to receive Holy Communion. Masks may be removed while seated in the pew, if so desired. If approaching to receive Holy Communion, please remove your mask just prior to receiving Our Lord, and moving it to cover your mouth and nose while returning to your pew. Please bring a personal mask with you. Ushers will have a limited supply for those who forget to bring a mask. Masks must be worn whenever adequate social distancing of at least six feet cannot be maintained in the pew.

DISTANCE — Everyone must maintain a distance of six feet from family groups and/or other individuals. Please follow the directions of our ushers and any signs or markings on pews and aisles.

HYMNALS & MISSALETTES — All hymnals, missalettes and other paper materials are stored until after the pandemic protocols are lifted. We encourage you to bring your smartphone to reference prayers, songs and other devotions that are available through various mobile apps. Printed missalettes and weekly bulletins are available on the rectory porch for your personal use. If you pick up a missalette, please take it home with you. The song texts for Sunday Mass can be found on our parish Facebook page and parish website.

HOLY COMMUNION — Please follow the directions of the ushers and any floor marking to maintain the six-foot distance between the faithful in the line. Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand or on the tongue. For those wishing to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, a kneeler is also provided for your use. The Ministers of Holy Communion will sanitize their fingers after distributing Holy Communion on the tongue of each individual.

TITHING — Thank you for your continuing generosity in this challenging time. Please continue to make use of automatic bank drafts, mailed contributions, or placing envelopes in the slot on the rectory porch. There will also be a stationary basket placed in the center aisle during Sunday Masses so that you may leave your contribution there.

A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR

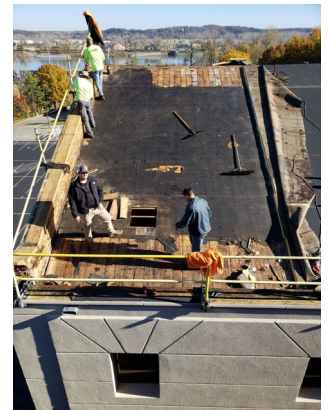
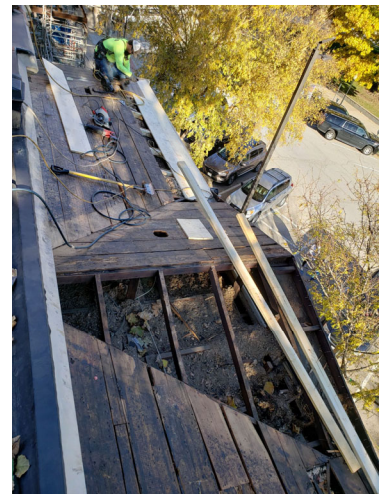
Dear friends in Christ –

The Lord provided us with a beautiful week of weather so that the various roof projects on campus could advance. As was noted in a previous bulletin, a significant amount of the decking on the church steeple was rotted to such a point that it would not hold nails. In order to provide a strong surface to which underlayment and the new slate can be attached, new 1x8" lumber is being installed. As of the end of last week, over 350' linear feet of decking was replaced on the steeple gables and hips (right above the clocks).

Speaking of decking, it was also discovered this past week that a large portion of the rectory porch roof decking (and the underlying rafters themselves) have suffered significant water penetration over the years. Those are being replaced for the structural integrity of the porch roof. Replacement of the rubber membrane – also known as EPDM – on the Selinger Centre also began this week. A roof access hatch is being restored to that building so that regular inspection and maintenance of that building can occur.

With all of this construction work, it requires a large number of construction workers and equipment. Please know that I have been attempting to maintain adequate parking for all of you during the week, but oftentimes 100' foot cranes don't easily fit in a single parking spot. And so to this end, I ask for your continued patience particularly when parking and church or school access isn't readily available. Many sincere thanks to those of you who have dropped an extra check by for the "unexpected discoveries" in this work. You can view more pictures of the work on our website at saintpeterjc.org. 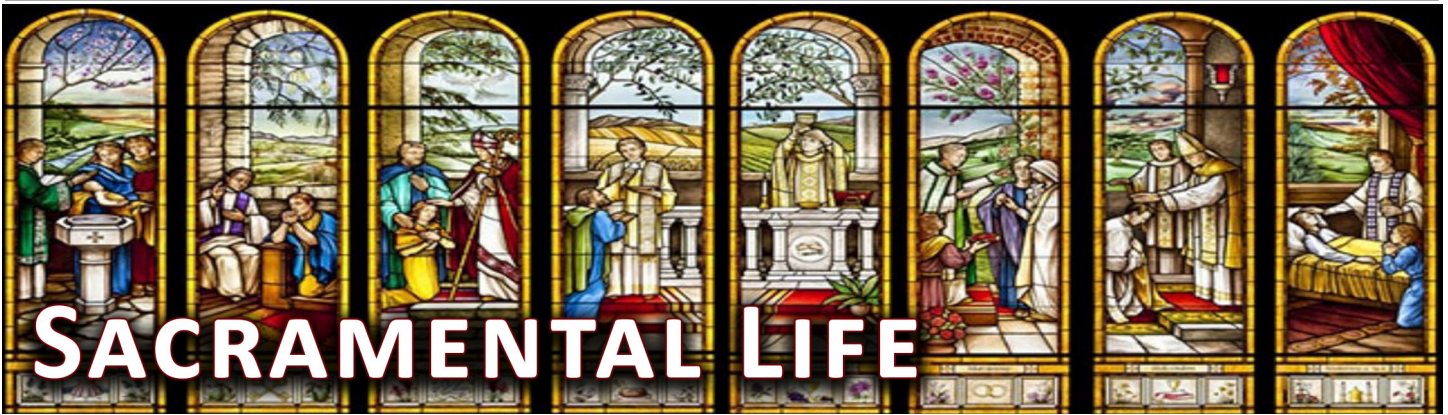

SACRAMENTAL LIFE

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to *check* available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be **scheduled after approval** by the priest and **at least a minimum of six months** prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the parish office to sign up.

Confirmation Preparation

Those in 7th & 8th Grade in St. Peter Interparish School and the St. Peter PSR Program, will be prepared for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation in their respective classes.

All those parishioners of high school age or older who have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation are asked to please register.

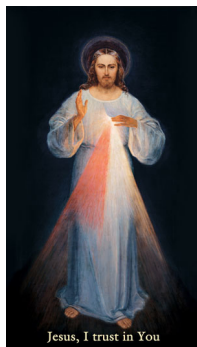
Anointing of the Sick

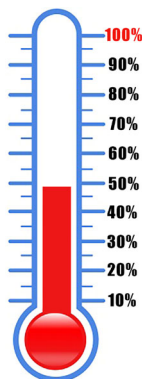

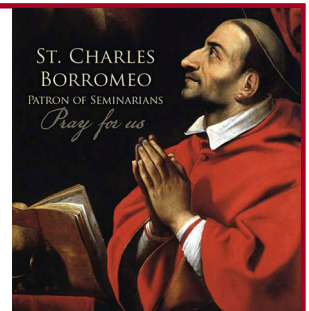

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

Reflecting on the great gift of your Guardian Angel.

In this time of concern regarding the pandemic, job security, social unrest, we try to focus on what we can do to stay as healthy – physically, spiritually, and mentally, as possible. Articles abound suggesting what we need to do – wear masks, wash your hands, practice social distancing, etc. and for our mental health it is suggested that we meditate, play music, play board games with family or other ways to relax and refresh. In addition, for our spiritual health we are encouraged to meditate and to pray, focusing on the Father, the Holy Spirit, Jesus, Mary, scripture, lives of the saints, etc. Another thing we might do to “settle ourselves” is to remember that each of us has a guardian angel. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states “From its beginning until death, human life is surrounded by their [guardian angels] watchful care and intercession...Beside each believer stands an angel as protector

and shepherd leading him to life” (Para. 336). Fr. Thomas Hinni, C.M. writes, “Let us remember that we have a companion, a spiritual guide, our guardian angel, who is there for us. When we feel lonely, saddened by the loss of loved ones, or facing sickness ourselves (like COVID-19), let us continue to turn to our guardian angel for assistance, for comfort and spiritual guidance.” (AMM Fall Bulletin, 2020, p.4).

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here, ever this day, be at my side, to light and guard to rule and guide. Amen
