#### Am I My Brother's Keeper? Yes, We Are!

Following the release of Bishop McKnight's August 21 Decree, the following REVISED protocols are now in effect for all Masses — Weddings and Funerals included — at St. Peter Parish until further notice.

Please know that we are carefully monitoring all directives and guidelines issued by state and local governments, as well as by the Diocese of Jefferson City, and will re-evaluate and adjust these protocols as warranted.

**HEALTH** — All the faithful are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice provided the Lord's Day is kept holy by participating in the live-streamed Sunday Mass; praying with the readings of the Sunday Mass; and/or reciting the rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet. Those with underlying health issues are encouraged to avoid the risk of large public gatherings such as Sunday Mass. Please check your temperature and general well-being before coming to church. Those who are symptomatic for COVID-19 are not permitted to enter church. Pews and hard surfaces are sanitized after each Sunday Mass.

**SEASONAL GATHERINGS** – In-person seasonal gatherings outside of Mass, such as penance services or vespers are discouraged.

MASKS – Everyone must wear a mask upon entering the church, throughout the Mass, and while moving in the Communion Procession to receive Holy Communion. If approaching to receive Holy Communion, please remove your mask just prior to receiving Our Lord, and moving it to cover your mouth and nose while returning to your pew. Please bring a personal mask with you. Ushers will have a limited supply for those who forget to bring a mask.

**DISTANCE** – Everyone must maintain a distance of six feet from family groups and/or other individuals. Please follow the directions of our ushers and any signs or markings on pews and aisles.

**HYMNALS & MISSALETTES** – All hymnals, missalettes and other paper materials are stored until after the pandemic protocols are lifted. We encourage you to bring your smartphone to reference prayers, songs and other devotions that are available through various mobile apps. Printed missalettes and weekly bulletins are available on the rectory porch for your personal use. If you pick up a missalette, please take it home with you. The song texts for Sunday Mass can be found on our parish Facebook page and parish website.

**HOLY COMMUNION** – Please follow the directions of the ushers and any floor marking to maintain the six-foot distance between the faithful in the line. Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand or on the tongue. For those wishing to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, a kneeler is also provided for your use. The Ministers of Holy Communion will sanitize their fingers after distributing Holy Communion on the tongue of each individual.

**TITHING** – Thank you for your continuing generosity in this challenging time. Please continue to make use of automatic bank drafts, mailed contributions, or placing envelopes in the slot on the rectory porch. There will also be a stationary basket placed in the center aisle during Sunday Masses so that you may leave your contribution there.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK**— If at all possible please seek the anointing of the sick from the parish priest before going to the hospital. We cannot guarantee that a priest will either be available or allowed into the hospital because of pandemic protocols.

# A NOTE REGARDING THE 8:00 AM WEEKDAY MASS ON TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY

Please note that the 8:00 am Weekday Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday is when the children from St. Peter Interparish School attend Mass. Due to COVID restrictions the children are required to sit in certain pews and next to designated individuals. This is to mitigate the spread of COVID among the students.

If you are an adult attending the 8:00 am Weekday Mass please sit in the back of the church to ensure the students are able to follow the necessary protocols for them to attend Mass and remain safe.

#### A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear friends in Christ,

The Lord has blessed us with many dry days this December, even if chilly some days.
The cooperative weather has allowed crews from the various trades to accomplish lots of work. The new copper through-wall flashing on the west parapet wall has been installed. More stainless steel pins will be installed in order to hold the new limestone capstones. Tuck pointing work continues on that part of the church.



On the nave roof of church, the removal of the clay tile continues. Having removed the numerous layers of tar paper, some rotted  $1 \times 10^{\circ}$  have been replaced on the roof deck. Once

all of the roof deck is firmed up, felt / ice & water guard will be laid and then a batten system will be installed. The use of batten systems is almost universal in Europe on slate roofs and it consists of both vertical and horizontal 1" members to be installed in order to level out the undulations of the roof deck so that the slate will rest level across the whole of the roof. There are other benefits in using a batten system including providing an air space between the decking and




the roof, adding in the longevity of the underlayment and wood decking. Because the slate will be nailed to the battens - at the average of 34 nails per square vs. 390 directly nailed per square through the 40# felt / ice & water guard, there would be many fewer penetrations.

When you drive by church on a sunny day, you might have

noticed the new copper hips and valleys on the steeple shining through. Slate installation on the steeple has begun and will take some weeks to complete.

Keepsake portions of the roof and steeple are available for you and your families to obtain for a suggested donation. Kindly note that all are unique, hand-selected from the steeple by yours truly and limited in number.



#### **Holy Matrimony**

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

#### **Baptism**

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up. Next classes will be in February 2021.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

If you are preparing for surgery, please let your priest know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.







## COVID-19 IS STILL HERE: DON'T LET YOUR GUARD DOWN!

Despite the presence of a vaccine, the high level of infection will not suddenly turn around. A "surge upon a surge" is predicted over the holidays. The next two months are predicted to be the worst yet, and cases of COVID continue to climb. In addition, the FLU (influenza) season is actively underway and the same safety precautions apply to both.

To keep ourselves and others safe while at St. Peter Church, we will continue to adhere to the following health safety measures:

## Wear A Mask coming into church, throughout Mass, and while leaving.

Why? COVID-19 spreads easily from person to person, mainly by the following routes:

- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within 6 feet).
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes, breathes, sings or talks.
- Respiratory droplets cause infection when they are inhaled or deposited on mucous membranes, such as those that line the inside of the nose and mouth.
- People who are infected but do not have symptoms can also spread the virus to others.
- A mask will protect both you and others around you.

## Maintain Social Distance (6 feet apart) coming into church, throughout Mass, and while leaving.

Why? COVID-19 spreads mainly among people who are in close contact (within about 6 feet) for a prolonged period.

- Spread happens when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks, and droplets from their mouth or nose are launched into the air and land in the mouths or noses of people nearby.
- The droplets can also be inhaled into the lungs.
- Recent studies indicate that people who are infected but do not have symptoms likely also play a role in the spread of COVID-19.
- Since people can spread the virus before they know they are sick, it is important to stay at least 6 feet away from others, even if you—or they—do not have any symptoms.
- St. Peter pews (and chairs in Selinger center) are marked or arranged to provide for the 6-foot distance.
- We thank you for following these safety measures and hope you have a blessed and safe Christmas time.


