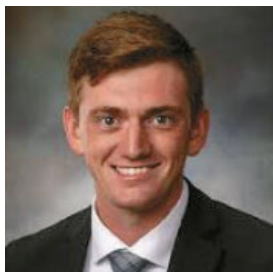
Due to early bulletin deadline, the mass counts for the weekend of December 16 and 17, 2024 were not available. They will be provided in the next bulletin.

COST OF CANDLES INCREASE

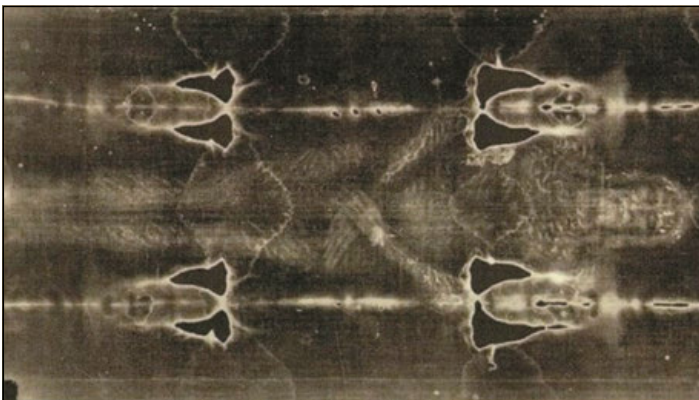

THE ST. PETER CONFERENCE OF THE SOCIETY OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL strives to provide support for the poor and needy in ways that are underserved by other organizations. Our goal is to be as generous as possible within our means without duplicating assistance already being provided by other organizations. So far that includes:

- Help prevent utilities from being disconnected. Having electric, gas, or water service disconnected has a domino effect; without electricity or water the home becomes uninhabitable. Families may become separated as children may be removed from the home. Not having utilities usually breaks the rental lease and the family may become homeless. By stepping in to prevent disconnection we help prevent further crises for the family being served.

- Provide basic twin size mattresses with priority given to children. Many of the people we help have had to move recently and, with no truck available, leave many possessions behind. Mattresses are particularly difficult to move without a truck and so many end up sleeping directly on the floor.

- Other types of assistance may be given, but these are the most common.
