BAPTISM

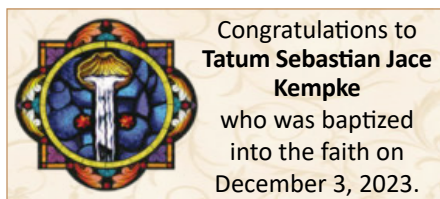

Sale-A-Rama 2023 brought in \$11,000 net! The committee will be giving a check to the parish for that amount to be used toward a new sound system in church.

This fundraiser has the potential to be of great benefit to our parish each year, but it is not possible without a committee to run it. There are dedicated volunteers who help in various positions year after year, but it takes a few people to run the event and make it successful. For 2024's event, Sale-A-Rama needs:

This event does not take a lot of time until the weekend of the event, but it does need attention from July (when vendor letters get mailed out) until the event. Michelle Truesdale and Gloria Lane, the current chair and treasurer, are willing to train a new group of volunteers to run the event in 2024, but they cannot continue running it after many years of doing so.

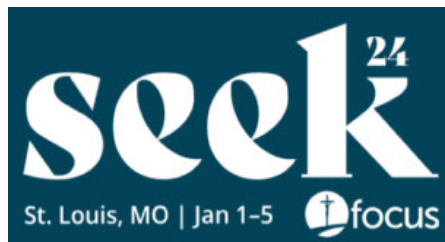

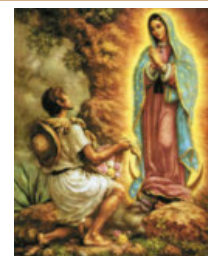
