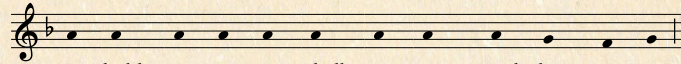

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

Anointing of the Sick

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

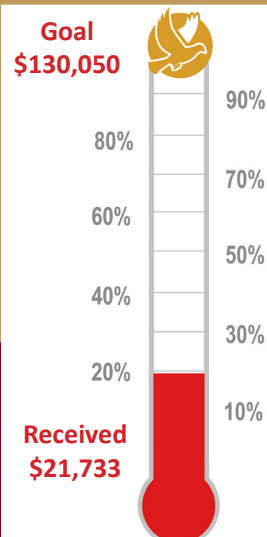

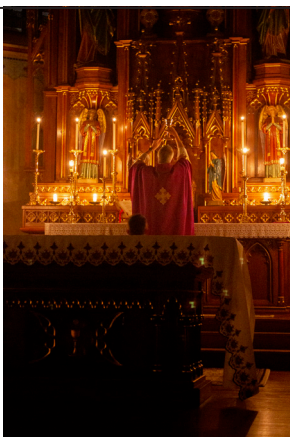

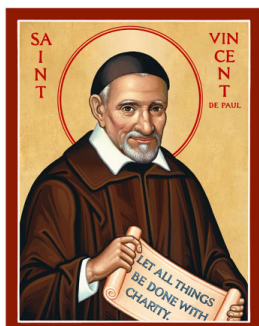
As you make final preparations for Christmas, focus on three things: *Holy, Happy, Healthy.*

Make it holy with prayerful preparation and joyful celebration at Christmas Mass.

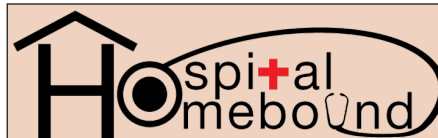
Make it happy, giving love and joy through sharing your time and love with family and friends, with those you meet and greet, and maybe with someone homebound or in a nursing home.

Make it healthy as you make wise choices regarding Christmas meals and treats.

Traditional foods such as turkey, salmon, sprouts, dried fruit and nuts in shells are good for you, so choose them along with snacks that feature protein. And plenty of fruits and vegetables. Chocolate brands with high cocoa content (60-70%) have much less impact on blood sugar than other brands, are more satisfying, and help you eat less and enjoy it more. Don't forget to exercise and drink plenty of water. Promptly refrigerate your leftovers to prevent bacterial growth. And keep your home safe with careful attendance to Christmas lights, candles, fireplaces, trees, and wiring.
