The Mass takes its title, Rorate Caeli, from the first words of the Introit, which are from Isaiah 45:8:

"Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem."
"Drop down dew, from above you heavens, and let the clouds rain the Just One: let the earth be opened and bring forth a Saviour."

The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. Reception to follow in the Notre Dame Room.

## Alice Kuehn's Nurse Notes

As you make final preparations for Christmas, focus on three things: Holy, Happy, Healthy

Make it holy with prayerful preparation and joyful celebration at Christmas Mass

Make it happy, giving love and joy through sharing you time and your love with family and friends, with those you meet and greet, maybe with someone homebound or in a nursing home.
Make it healthy as you make wise choices regarding Christmas meals and treats. Traditional foods such as turkey, salmon, sprouts, dried fruit and nuts in
shells (take longer to eat that way!) are good for you, so choose them along with snacks that feature protein, vegetables and fruits. Chocolate brands with high cocoa content (60-70\%) have much less impact on blood sugar than lesser brands, are more satisfying, and help you eat less and enjoy it more. Don't forget to exercise - walking is very good -water is a very healthy and satisfying drink. Promptly refrigerate your leftovers. And keep your home safe with careful attendance to Christmas lights, candles, fireplaces, trees, and wiring.
