NURSE'S NOTES

Spotlighted Column Topics: *Lenten preparation, fasting, 8 Dimensions of Wellness*

My plan for this week’s column is to focus on tying our Lenten fasting and sacrifices to the various dimensions of wellness. As I pondered this topic, I chuckled as I fondly recalled anecdotes from my St. Peter School days. As young children we understood in a basic sense that we were supposed to “give something up for Lent”. I vividly recall classmates giddily yelling down the alleyway to peers in passing: “Hey, guess what! I’m giving up **green beans** for Lent!” (or some other unpleasant-to-them food or activity that would not be hard to give up). Goodness, did we think we were clever!

We are called to work on all 3 pillars of our Catholic Lenten season ~ *Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving*. The concept of “giving up something for Lent” falls under the Fasting pillar. Indeed, “fasting is actually a form of penance, which helps us turn away from sin and toward Christ. . . . The more serious side of Lenten discipline is that it’s about more than self-control – it’s about finding aspects of yourself that are less than Christ-like and letting them die” (Bishop Ricken, 2018, p. 1).

A few years back, I came across this attention-grabbing quote about behavior change ~ *If it's not hard, then you're doing it wrong*. “Fasting requires me to do something difficult that no one else is going to see. In addition, it also causes us to face our personal demons, our greed, and our inability to deny ourselves” (Fr. Caleb Vogel, as cited in Chaplin, 2025, para. 18). Referring to my childhood story above, we were overfocused on the **giving-up** part but clearly missed (perhaps purposely) the **sacrificial** part. Fasting is not just about deprivation (giving up); it can also involve doing something extra (or positive), such as attending daily Mass, adding daily physical activity, or saying a daily rosary.

Previously, I have discussed the **8 Dimensions of Wellness**, as a nod to the importance of caring for ourselves *holistically*. As we head into Lent and ponder our personal fasting plans, contemplate all the angles that *can* be approached in reference to these 8 wellness dimensions. This is *not* a call to sacrifice in all dimensions, but rather simply a way to view each wellness dimension through a Christian lens as we head into our holiest, penitential season.

WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns, or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the **diojeffcity.org** webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated. All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.
