

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

It may be cold outside, but remember, this is the month when our thoughts turn to love. Our faith tells us to love God, our neighbor and ourselves. The Baltimore Catechism said we should love God because He is infinitely perfect and lovable, because He created, redeemed and sanctified us, and because He preserves us and gives us many blessings every day. 




