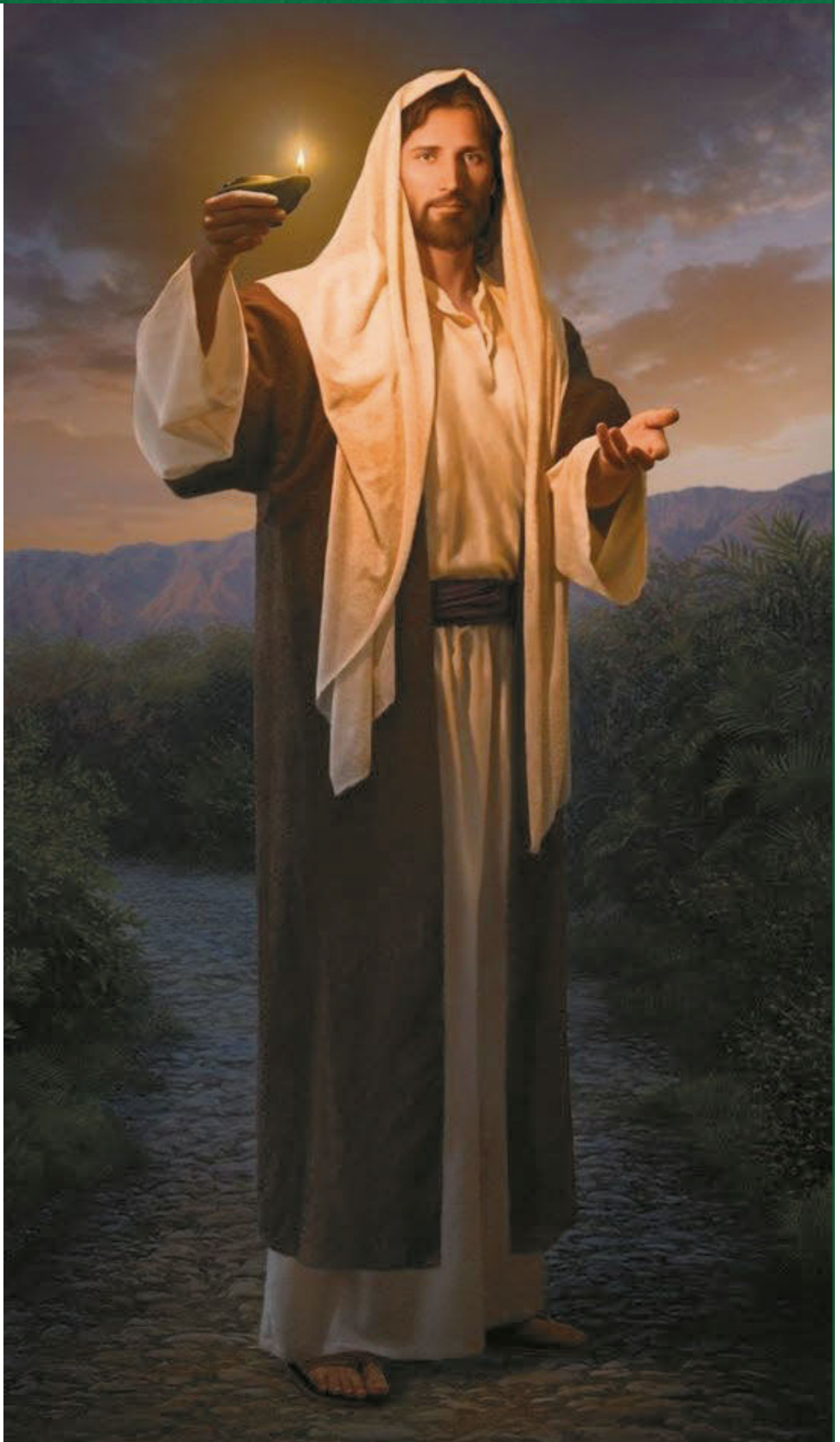

SACRAMENTAL LIFE

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

Anointing of the Sick

If you are preparing for surgery, please let our priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

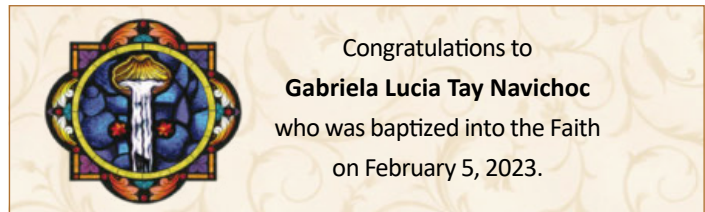
Catholic Inquiry and Faith Formation (formerly R.C.I.A.)

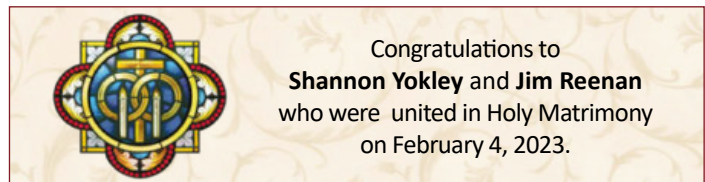

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

FEBRUARY IS AMERICAN HEART MONTH

During the month of February, we celebrate St. Valentine's day and recognize the human heart as the symbol of love. So it is not surprising that February is American Heart Month, a time to learn how to stay "heart healthy" for yourself and your loved ones.

Tips for staying "heart healthy:"

Get a checkup at least once each year, even if you feel healthy. A health care professional can check for conditions that put you at risk for CVD, such as high blood pressure and diabetes. Get your blood pressure and cholesterol checked; eat a healthy diet, choosing plenty of fresh fruits and vegetables (adults should have at least five servings each day). Select foods low in saturated fat, trans fat, and cholesterol and high in fiber and eat less sodium. Go low on sugars and sweets and avoid foods with "high fructose corn syrup." Maintain a healthy weight. To determine whether your weight is in a healthy range, check your Body Mass Index (BMI). If you know your weight and height, you can calculate your BMI at CDC's Assessing Your Weight Web site and exercise regularly. The Surgeon General recommends that adults should engage in moderate-intensity activity for at least 150 minutes per week. Perhaps use the stairs instead of the elevator; rake the yard and walk, walk, walk. For more healthy living tips visit <https://www.cdc.gov/healthyliving/index.html>.
