NURSE NOTES

Spotlighted Column Topics: heart health, online health education resources



February is **American Heart Month**, sponsored by the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLBI) and one of its health education programs, *The Heart Truth*. Heart disease is the leading cause of death in the United States (CDC, 2025). That heavy reality can be scary to think about, especially if we have several known cardiac risk factors or if heart disease is prevalent in our family lineage. Refreshingly, the purpose of the **American Heart Month** campaign is “motivating Americans to adopt healthy lifestyles to prevent heart disease” (NHLBI, 2026, para. 1). The NHLBI has a plethora of fantastic online

learning materials to assist us with improving heart health. I will aim to get some hard copies, as well. Below I have spotlighted several of my favorite resources, though please consider exploring the **American Heart Month** website (<https://www.nhlbi.nih.gov/education/american-heart-month>) for more specific information related to your heart health status, risk factors, and education topics for your physical health journey. For any of these resources ~ either listed below or those you may come across on the provided links ~ please ensure your safety. That is, participation should align with health and nutrition guidelines from your doctor/provider and your own physical capabilities.

 - Example: 2/8’s suggestion is “Choose a new herb or spice to try instead of salt”. The Learn More-link connects to their fact sheet listing numerous non-salt herbs and spices and what food groups they would best flavor.
- ✓ **28 Days Towards a Healthy Heart:** <https://www.nhlbi.nih.gov/resources/28-days-towards-healthy-heart> ~ This one has 28 days (like February), but it is set up more general so it could be used for any 28-day timeframe. (Technically, Day 4 is February-specific.) Perhaps we could consider using this guide *every* month!

WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns, or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the diojeffcity.org webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated.

All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.
