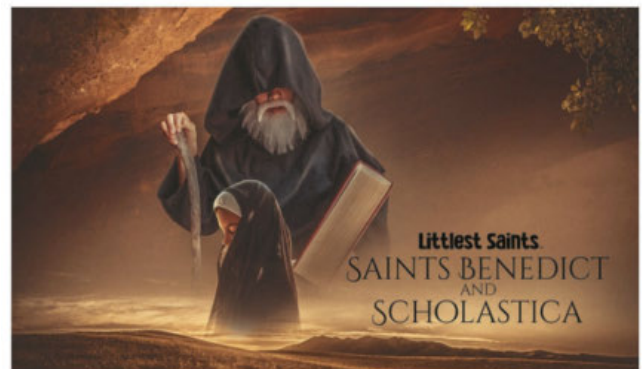

## FUNERAL LUNCHEONS

Thanks to all for volunteering to bring side dishes, and or help set-up and clean-up for funeral luncheons! In 2024, we served 21 funerals. We have 226 participants who have signed up to bring food and 66 participants to help serve the meals for family members and friends following the funeral Masses.

Two ladies serve as monthly chairpersons. They and other ladies or gentlemen help set-up, prepare food, serve, and clean up. One of the chairpersons is notified by the Parish Office that we have a funeral and immediately steps into action by contacting the family, offering condolences, and getting a head count so we can begin planning how much food is needed. The food callers then send out an email to request food. We want to especially thank Dolores Lauf for setting up the email procedure to request food and updating the guidelines for funeral luncheons. The food list fills up quickly by our very generous volunteers. The chairpersons then call 6-8 volunteers to work the day of the funeral to serve the meal, set-up and clean up. It is a very rewarding service provided by our parish.

The families are always very appreciative and express their gratitude for hosting the meal.

The service is provided without charge to the family, however, donations are frequently given and very much appreciated. We want to thank our monthly chairpersons, without them, we could not perform this service. Iron Riders: The Story of the 25th Infantry Regiment Bicycle Corps

In 1897, the all-Black 25th Infantry Regiment Bicycle Corps embarked on an epic ride of more than 1,900 miles from Fort Missoula, Montana, to St. Louis, Missouri, as part of a U.S. Army experiment to determine the effectiveness of moving troops by bicycle. Dubbed "The Great Experiment" by national newspapers, the journey took 41 days to complete, following a route that closely mirrored the Northern Pacific and Burlington railroads through Montana, Wyoming, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Missouri. Nicknamed the "Iron Riders" due to the heavy one-speed bicycles they pedaled, the soldiers faced grueling conditions that would challenge even the most experienced cyclists today. Join us as Missouri State Parks historian Kevin Smith recounts these hardships and how the Iron Riders ultimately reached St. Louis.

**BREAKING THE SILENCE OF ABUSE**

As a diocese, we are committed to breaking the silence of abuse. When someone is reporting abuse, we must acknowledge their pain and how difficult it is to talk about. False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. For those who need to report abuse, encourage them to contact our Victim's Assistance Coordinator, **Jacqueline Baldwin (573-694-3199)**, and to make use of the appropriate State of Missouri hotline (1-800-392-3738) or the Attorney General's clergy abuse online form. All of this information is also on our website, under the 'report abuse' tab. For those who want information or want to convey a message to Bishop McKnight, please encourage them to write to us at reportabuse@diojeffcity.org.

**WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE**

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns, or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the **diojeffcity.org** webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated. All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.
