**HOLY MATRIMONY**

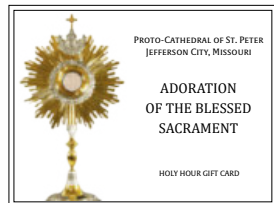

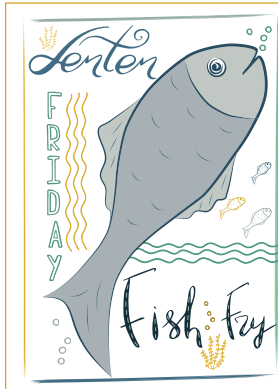
