



#### **ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES**

#### **Health Eating Tips** (continued)

Bump up your fiber. Fiber in your diet not only keeps you regular, it also helps you feel fuller longer. Fiber also helps control blood sugar and lowers cholesterol levels. Fresh fruits and vegetables, whole grains, and legumes (beans and peas) are good sources of fiber. Slice up raw veggies and keep them in to-go baggies to use as quick snacks. Start your day off with a high-fiber breakfast like whole grain oatmeal sprinkled with pecans or macadamia nuts. Steam veggies rather than boiling them. When buying frozen veggies, look for ones that have been "flash frozen."

Aim for a variety of colors on your plate. Foods like dark, leafy greens, oranges, and tomatoes are loaded with vitamins, fiber, and minerals. Sprinkle fresh herbs over a salad or whole wheat pasta. Make a red sauce using canned tomatoes (look for "low sodium" or "no salt added"), fresh herbs, and spices. Add diced veggies like peppers, broccoli, or onions to stews and omelets to give them a boost of color and nutrients.

Are you eating healthy to help you get to a healthy weight? According to the Dietary Guidelines for Americans 2020–2025 a healthy eating plan:

- Emphasizes fruits, vegetables, whole grains, and fat-free or low-fat milk and milk products
- Includes a variety of protein foods such as seafood, lean meats and poultry, eggs, legumes (beans and peas), soy products, nuts, and seeds.
- Is low in saturated fats, trans fats, cholesterol, salt (sodium), and added sugars
- Stays within your daily calorie needs
- USDA's MyPlate Plan can help you identify what and how much to eat from the different food groups while staying within your recommended calorie allowance.
