#### **Holy Matrimony**

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

#### **Baptism**

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.





#### ST. PETER SCHOOL NEWS

We are a very busy bunch in 4R!

Near the end of October we researched a favorite saint and then created a life-sized saint poster to display in the hallway. The kids also shared what

they had learned about their saint with the rest of the class.

In November we solved mysteries using our inference skills for Reading class. The students had to work cooperatively to read the clues given and decide who the "criminal" was in each scenario. We also took a trip to the Capitol grounds to see the statue commemorating the signing of the Louisiana Purchase. This was much nicer than looking at it in our textbook.

The week before Christmas break we focused our Science skills on STEM activities to get the students moving and learning at the same time. In this activity they worked in groups of 4 to use a rubber band with 4 strings attached to move and release a cup in the correct position to create a Christmas tree. These are just a few of the things we've been up to this year so far. 2023 looks to be exciting, too!



#### **ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES**

Here we are, beginning a New Year. If you are one to make resolutions, keep them simple and attainable. The church year has already begun, so your spiritual resolutions may have already been formed during Advent. Now take stock of your mental and physical health - look at how you can reduce stress and busyness in your daily living, and focus on finding the little joys of each day.

The third week of January is Watch your Weight Week – resolve to look closely at your daily diet and exercise routine or non-routine and work to make them a healthier part of your life. There are about 800,000 strokes each year in the United States and many of us have risk factors that could lead to strokes. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention notes that:

"High blood pressure, high cholesterol and smoking are key risk factors for stroke. About half of Americans have at least one of these three risk factors." Other risk factors include being overweight, physically inactive, and drinking too much alcohol. Your New Year's resolutions could include a resolve to look closely at your daily diet and life style and work towards a healthier life.
