with the completion of the asbestos removal, the wood flooring will be acclimating to the environment of church. The nave floor installation is scheduled to begin during the week of July 19th. Also note that with the completion of the relocation of sanctuary ductwork, the lower chapel will again be available for prayer and the lighting of votive candles.



#### **Holy Matrimony**

Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

#### **Baptism**

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

If you are preparing for surgery, please let your priest know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

As the Delta variant of the COVID-19 virus continues to make headway in Missouri, the Missouri Catholic Conference wants to let you know that the Missouri Department of Health is offering free at-home testing kits, as well as free testing at local community testing sites. The location for Central Missouri is:

Jefferson City, MO 65101 July 18, Aug. 8, 22, Sept. 12, 26

There is no pre-registration or appointment needed to receive a test. Having a state issued identification card available at the testing site will speed up the process immensely; however, no identification documents are required. As long as you arrive before the event closes, you will be guaranteed to receive a test. Results will be available as soon as possible, but no later than 72 hours from the event.

Self testing allows for ordering a kit to be shipped to your home. After self-collection by easy-to-follow instructions, the kit is returned to a laboratory free of charge via FedEx. You must provide an email address in order to receive the test result. Once ordered, the kit arrives in 2 days. The kit is good for 6 months. Once the sample has been collected, it must be packaged in the prepaid FedEx shipping envelope (according to directions) and returned to a FedEx collection site within 24 hours. Here is a brief summary of the main facts regarding COVID-19 vaccines and vaccination status: As of June 22, 2021, Cole County's COVID-19 vaccination rate was approximately 40%. COVID19 vaccines are currently available at least fourteen locations in Cole County. The Cole County Community Vaccination Site at the Capital Mall offers vaccines on Thursdays. Both Pfizer and Johnson and Johnson vaccines are available. Register at covidvaccine.mo.gov or walk-in any time between noon and 4 pm. Appointment times are available until 5:40 pm. The community site will offer vaccinations until July 15th.

The Jefferson City Medical Group (COVID-19 Vaccine Registration | Jefferson City Medical Group (jcmg.org)) and retail pharmacies also have vaccine available. Most retail pharmacies (like HyVee, Wal-Mart, and Target) are open every day and do not require an appointment. All vaccination locations in Missouri can be found on covidvaccine.mo.gov by clicking on "Get a Vaccine" and then "Find

a Vaccine". Enter your zip code to find vaccine locations near you.
