

# **STEWARDSHIP SACRIFICIAL TITHING & GIVING CLARIFICATION**

We have had several questions regarding what adjustments need to be made to your regular method of sacrificial tithing and giving in the new Stewardship model.

If you normally give using envelopes, you will notice that there are now fewer envelopes in your monthly packet. You will only see envelopes for Church Contribution, St. Vincent dePaul and Facilities and Property Maintenance. The funds that you previously donated to other collections (i.e. Catholic Stewardship Appeal, Retirement Fund for Religious, etc.) should now be rolled into the envelope for Church Contribution. Checks for Church Contribution and Facilities and Property Maintenance should be made out to St. Peter Church. If you donate to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, your check should be made out directly to Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

If you have funds automatically deducted from your checking account and need to adjust the amount please send an email to bmccracken@saintpeterjc.org. Please state in the email the amount to be adjusted and the date it should take effect. You do not need to contact your bank. As long as we have your request in writing, Beverly McCracken, our Business Manager, can make the adjustment for you.

If you normally give online through your credit/debit card, you will need to go into the St. Peter App (either on your computer on your phone) and click on My Giving. You will be able to adjust your contribution here.

Please keep in mind that just because the envelopes/listed collection is no longer visible doesn't mean the need has disappeared. What you would normally give to these other collections is now part of your normal Church Contribution. # SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DEPAUL

Thank you for your generous donations to St. Vincent de Paul! In the last six months, SVDP has been able to

help 200 families, which improved the lives of nearly 500 people. The majority of your contributions provided utility assistance to prevent utility disconnections, as well as purchase fuel to enable people to get to work and doctor appointments.

In addition to providing direct assistance, volunteers answered many more calls to inform people where food banks and shelters are located, and made referrals to other agencies. Catholic Charities of Central and Northern Missouri provided a \$5,000 grant to purchase beds for children. Twenty four twin beds have been provided so far.

The Salvation Army dinner which SVDP provides, continues to feed 40 to 50 people each month. A big thank you to all the volunteers who bring food and help serve the meal at the shelter.


SVDP could not do any of these things without the support of our parishioners!


