



LIFE-SIZE CRUCIFIX

When the church interior renovation twenty years ago was in its initial stages, one parishioner in particular asked repeatedly that we place the life-size crucifix back in the church. It was removed in the 1980's and placed in what we called "the shrine room" in the present ramp entrance. I arrived in the parish in 1995 and the ramp entrance was special to me because of this large crucifix surrounded by candles parishioners lit for various prayer needs. The stained glass window enhanced this shrine room. This was a place of prayer for many and the crucifix at eye level helped us become more aware of Christ's sufferings and death for our sins.

There were other plans for this entrance

at that time and so our committee ensured that this special crucifix returned to our sanctuary. My perspective from the choir loft was much like in the former shrine room. My eyes always look first at the tabernacle and speak a word of love to Jesus and then they gaze at our beautiful Jesus on the cross repeatedly during Mass. I've often wondered how many people gaze upwards at the crucifix from their pew below. This stance reminds me of Mary standing below the crucifix on Calvary. What agony she suffered. We can relate to our Mother Mary's agony when we are going through trials, sufferings and tribulations. Call on her and ask her to obtain strength for you.

From the choir loft, the crucifix is directly in front of me, just like in the shrine room. There is greater distance, but I see Jesus directly in front of me. Aren't we called to keep Jesus directly in front of us? If Jesus is in front of us, He is leading us, rather than we getting ahead of Him. Jesus in front of us keeps us humble, reminding us Who Jesus is and how great He is. He calls us to be like Him and to follow in His footsteps, even to the cross in our lives. It is through our cross that we will enter into glory and share eternal life with Him.

Pope Francis emphasizes in his message for that day that the Lord is always with us and always calling us to play a role in spreading the Gospel no matter our age. "I was called to become the Bishop of Rome when I had reached, so to speak, retirement age and thought I would not be doing anything new. The Lord is always – always - close to us. He is close to us with new possibilities, new ideas, new consolations, but always close to us. You know that the Lord is eternal; He never, ever goes into retirement."

Pope Francis focuses on two main points: First, there are "angels" who are there for the grandparents and the elderly and Second, for the grandparents and elderly there is no retirement age "from the work of proclaiming the Gospel and handing down traditions to your grandchildren" and those around you.

In relation to the First point, the Pope mentions that according to tradition, Saint Joachim, the grandfather of Jesus, felt very isolated because he and his wife, Anne, had no children. The Lord sent an angel to tell him that his prayer was answered and they became the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Pope notes that the Lord continues to send angels to console us in our loneliness and to remind us: "I am with you always."

The Pope then prays that "every grandfather, every grandmother, every older person, especially those among us who are most alone, receive the visit of an angel!" These "angels" might be family members, friends or visitors from St. Peter Church! In regards to this "first point," we are very blessed in St. Peter parish to have a group of Parish Outreach volunteers who are calling each parishioner on a regular basis to check on their well-being as well as to see if they have any spiritual or personal needs we can help them with. In addition we have the Caring Neighbors who work with the parish nurse, Fr. Secrist and Fr. Paschal to bring visits, love, caring and the sacraments to our parishioners who are homebound and those in nursing homes.
