



REFLECTIONS OF DEACON CHRISTOPHER HOFFMAN DURING HIS PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

Dec. 31, 2022, Tagbah, Israel

We were blessed today to have Mass in Tabgha near the Church of the Primacy of Peter which houses the Mensa Christi, the stone where Jesus made breakfast for the Apostles while they were out fishing after Jesus' Resurrection. (Jn 21) Mass was in one of the outdoor chapels with a mosaic of Pope Paul VI, who visited this site, along with all Popes since. We had a clear view of the Church and Sea of Galilee as the Gospel about the questioning of Peter's love for Christ and his call by Christ to shepherd His sheep was being proclaimed. I was able to look upon the site where this actually took place, in the mornig, with a view of the very sea where the Apostles and disciples were fishing.

During the liturgy of the Eucharist I reflected upon the fact that Jesus is again feeding His followers here on the seashore, but not with mere fish and bread but His Body and Blood. As I recieved Him in the Sacrament I am again saying, "I love you Jesus." We seminarians who are preparing to shepard God's sheep soon are also asked by Jesus, through the Church and formation, "Do you love Christ and will you shepard Christ's sheep?" I like Peter am able to answer, "yes, I love You, but not as fully as I ought." Peter was able to respond with filial love, while Christ asked for agape, or "all-in" love. Yet, Jesus accepted where Peter was and graced him with strength, leadership, and greater and greater faith. These are gifts I hope to recieve through my upcoming ordination, where I will declair that I will serve God's sheep before fully leading His flock as a priest of Jesus Christ.

2024 school year. Must be high school age as of August 1st and wanting to work with kids. If you would like to learn more about the job, you can email Ms. Betsy.




