


DAILY EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT



After consulting the Parish Pastoral Council, it has been decided to honor a forgotten, but notable pastor in the life of our parish by renaming the Selinger Hospitality

Center: MSGR. HOOG HALL

Our current and third church building was built under the watchful eye of our seventh pastor, Monsignor Otto Joseph Stanislaus Hoog (pronounced "h-oh-g").

Born April 8, 1845 in Ettenheim, Baden, Switzerland, he accompanied his parents to America in 1854 where they settled in St. Louis. That same year both parents died during the cholera epidemic, leaving their 9-year-old son an orphan. Fr. Uland, who prepared his parents for death, placed him in St. Vicent's Orphanage where he remained for five years. During this time young Otto felt the call to the priesthood. In 1859 he began his studies at St. Louis University. In September, 1861, he traveled to the Theological Seminary of St. Francis de Sales in St. Francis, Wisconsin. Four years later he was transferred to the St. Louis Diocesan Seminary, then located in Cape Girardeau.

Fr. Hoog was ordained to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ on December 21, 1867 in St. Louis by the Rt. Rev. Bishop Junker of Alton. He celebrated his first Holy Mass at St. Vincent's Orphan Asylum on December 27, 1867. Shortly after his ordination he was sent to Lexington, Missouri where is served as pastor until he was appointed to St. Peter Church in Jefferson City, following the death of Fr. Henry Meurs.

Fr. Hoog arrived in Jefferson City on September 20, 1876. During Fr. Hoog's pastorate, he oversaw the growth and expansion of

> St. Peter Parish. In 1881 Fr. Hoog had the second St. Peter Church that had been built in 1856. razed to make way for the



August 12 by Rt. Rev. P.J. Ryan, then Coadjutor-Bishop of St. Louis. The next project to be undertaken was the building of our current rectory in 1885. The first pastor of St. Peter, Fr.

construction of the current church. The new church was completed in 1883 and dedicated on Sunday,

> Murphy, dwelt in a log cabin until his reassignment in 1848. Subsequent pastors resided in a small house prior to the 1857 conversion of the original school building that had been constructed in 1854.

In 1889, Fr. Hoog razed the existing St. Peter School to make way for a larger two-story brick building with a basement. This structure still stands today and is currently in use as classrooms and the library today.


As a result of being made an orphan at the age of nine, one of Fr. Hoog's greatest concerns was the welfare of children. Fr. Hoog would host a breakfast for the boys and girls who finished the eighth grade. He would go to great lengths to make sure there was plenty of food for every child and that no child felt left out and fully participated in the banquet. On parishioner recounted how, "He would go from place to place around the table to urge them to make themselves at home."

During Fr. Hoog's twenty-eight year pastorate he had seventeen assistants. One of whom was Fr. Joseph Selinger who succeeded him as pastor.

Fr. Hoog was considered a great organizer and leader with a magnetic personality. He was as popular with the clergy and members of other religious beliefs as he was with the Catholic in Jefferson City.

On December 14, 1903, Archbishop Glennon asked Fr. Hoog to be his Vicar General. Protests were immediately made to the archbishop asking that Fr. Hoog remain in Jefferson City. Even Rev. J.F. Hendy, then pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Jefferson City, personally carried a petition signed by the "people at large" to St. Louis asking that Fr. Hoog be retained here. Fr. Hoog's response was that he was a soldier in the

> service of the Lord and he was subject to the orders of his superior, the archbishop. Fr. Hoog returned to St. Louis in August 1904. He was given the title of Monsignor on October 25, 1911 while pastor at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in St. Louis. He died on April 4, 1925 at St. Mary's Seminary in St. Louis.

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES

Staying Cool - Part Three

Keep Your Pets Hydrated: Provide plenty of fresh water for your pets and leave the water in a shady area.

Check for Updates: Check your local news for extreme heat alerts and safety tips and to learn about any cooling shelters in your area.

Use a Buddy System: When working in the heat, monitor the condition of your coworkers and have someone do the same for you. Heat-induced illness can cause a person to become confused or lose consciousness. If you are 65 years of age or older, have a friend or relative call to check on you twice a day during a heat wave. If you know someone in this age group, check on them at least twice a day.

Monitor Those at High Risk: Although anyone at any time can suffer from heat-related illness, some people are at greater risk than others: Infants and young children, people 65 years of age or older, people who are overweight, people who overexert during work or exercise or people who are physically ill, especially with heart disease or high blood pressure, or who take certain medications, such as for depression, insomnia, or poor circulation. Visit adults at risk at least twice a day and closely watch them for signs of heat exhaustion or heat stroke. Infants and young children, of course, need much more frequent watching.

Know the Signs: Learn the signs and symptoms of heat-related illnesses(https://www. cdc.gov/disasters/extremeheat/warning.html) and how to treat them.




