

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

RETURN TO REGULAR SCHEDULE OF ADORATION WITH EXPOSITION FO THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

St. Peter Parish will return to a regular schedule of Adoration with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, beginning the first full week of September 6-10, Monday-Friday, 8 am to 8 pm in the Chapel.

Exposition will begin each day, Monday through Friday, after the 8:00 am Mass and will continue until 8:00 pm that evening. Daily Mass will be celebrated upstairs in the church.

To facilitate sign up and scheduling we are using a software program called Adoration Pro. It is like the Ministry scheduling program St. Peter's uses for liturgical ministries and is very simple to use.

Here is the link and instructions to sign up for a weekly hour of adoration: https://adorationpro.org/saintpeterjc

- 1. Press the Weekly Commitment button.
- 2. That will take you to the schedule where you can select an hour. We need at least two adorers, (two different households) for each hour, so even if someone's name is next to an hour you can still sign up for that hour if the sign up button is present.
- 3. When you press the Sign up button for a specific hour/day that will take you to a page where you will enter your personal information. Don't forget to press the signup button at the bottom of that page.
- 4. An email will be sent to you confirming your weekly commitment. as well as contact information and information about requesting a sub.
- 5. You may be asked if you would like to serve as a sub, or you can sign up to be a sub on the original sign in page. You will receive an email confirming you have signed up and you can indicate your hours of availability.
- 6. When we begin Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in September you will receive a weekly text/email reminder the day before your hour of adoration.

The World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated annually on the fourth Sunday of July, beginning this year on July 25. Pope Francis emphasized in his message that the Lord is always with us and always calling us to play a role in spreading the Gospel no matter our age. "I was called to become the Bishop of Rome when I had reached, so to speak, retirement age and thought I would not be doing anything new. The Lord is always – always – close to us. He is close to us with new possibilities, new ideas, new consolations, but always close to us. You know that the Lord is eternal; He never, ever goes into retirement."

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

The Second point the Pope explains that "Grandparents and elderly have a new vocation in this time of life!" They need to undertake a new mission, using their life experiences and accumulated wisdom to help build the "world of tomorrow." He continues, noting that "the Lord's closeness will grant to all, even the frailest among us, the strength needed to embark on a new journey along the path of dreams, memory and prayer."

The elderly need to continue to dream dreams of justice, peace, and solidarity to help the young create visions of a new loving and compassionate world. However, to build on this new vision, we need memory, as it is the foundation for creating our future. "Keeping memory alive and sharing it with others is a very important and meaningful mission for every elderly person."

And then there is prayer. "As my predecessor, Pope Benedict wrote 'Your prayer is a very precious resource: a deep breath that the Church and the world urgently needs' (cf. Evangelii Gaudium, 262)." Here at St. Peter parish we have

a special ministry for our elderly and homebound – the Prayer Angels. Their ministry is the holy work of prayer for our St. Peter parishioners and others who are in need of prayers due to illness, grief, loneliness and other special needs. They receive a weekly letter with a meditation and then a listing of those who have asked for special prayers. This very special way they intercede for our parishioners and others in need is indeed a precious resource and gift. Pope Francis concludes: "Think about it: what is our vocation today, at our age? To preserve our roots, to pass on the faith to the young and to care for the little ones. Never forget this."

May our parish continue to build on our current work to not only acknowledge and address the needs of our grandparents and elderly, especially the homebound and those in nursing homes as well as to honor the very special ministry they have in sharing their dreams, keeping memory alive and praying for us, our church, our country and our world. 
