Dear friends in the Lord -

As you might have already heard, our new and refurbished church pews are to arrive back from Nebraska for reinstallation beginning on Monday, 18 July. It will take a number of days to reconstruct them and install the new kneelers. In preparation for the pew installation, maintenance will need to occur on the nave floor, as the extended period of time on moveable chairs has taken its toll on the finish.

And so for the weekdays of 11-15 July and 18-22 July, the 12:03 pm daily Mass will be celebrated in the chapel. The weekend Masses on 16-17 July will be in church; whereas the 2:00 pm Mass in Spanish on 10 & 17 July will be in the chapel.

Finally, please also note that during the month of July, there will not be an 8:00 am Mass celebrated at St. Peter Church, but Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will continue as normal.

Many thanks for your patience as we work to get this long-anticipated work completed.

You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.
