NURSE'S NOTES

Spotlighted Column Topics: *Almsgiving during Lent, charity, Mass of Anointing*

The concepts of love and charity are intricately interwoven throughout our scriptures and Catholic Church teachings. As the Body of Christ, we are called to strive to fulfill the second greatest commandment ~ that is, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Mark 12:31). Lent is a beautiful time for us to work on this, as one of our three pillars of the Lenten season is **Almsgiving**. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 2462) clarifies that almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God" (as cited at USCCB, n.d.). Amazingly, there are so many ways to manifest this second greatest commandment. In his helpful, 1-page summary *10 Things to Remember During Lent*, Bishop David Ricken (2018) reminds us on #9 of the list: **Reach out in charity**. He further clarifies ~ "It's about more than throwing a few extra dollars in the collection plate; it's about reaching out to others and helping them without question as a way of sharing the experience of God's unconditional love" (Ricken, 2018).

There are many beautiful opportunities St. Peter's Church and our nearby parishes offer us for prayer and growth during Lent, such as Stations of the Cross, penance services, and confessions. Another wonderful, healing opportunity our clergy provide during Lent is the **Mass of Anointing**. It is scheduled for this Friday, March 6 following the Noon Mass. Even if you are not in need of this sacrament, please consider **reaching out in charity** to support those needing this sacrament and/or assist us with this event if able. (There are certainly plenty of other ways to incorporate charity and almsgiving this Lenten season.) Please review below some ideas for assisting with this prayerful experience, **Mass of Anointing & luncheon details**, and the **sacramental explanation**.

Charitable Ways to Help with the Lenten Rite of Anointing

- ✓ Check in with St. Peter's parishioners you know who are homebound, impacted by illness/age, living in a retirement facility, or otherwise may need this sacrament. ~ Encourage them to participate in this Lenten opportunity if able. ~ Ensure they are aware of the event details and assist them to RSVP if applicable.
- ✓ Assist these parishioners who need transportation to the Anointing if able or notify Parish Nurse of the transportation need.
 - ✓ If you are available to assist with the luncheon or in other ways, reach out to Parish Nurse.
- ✓ If someone is physically unable to attend this Anointing but desires the sacrament: Reassure them they will be visited at home and notify Parish Nurse who will coordinate a visit.
- ✓ Keep in your prayers all those who persevere with the pain and challenges of aging, illness, and chronic conditions.

WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns, or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the **diojeffcity.org** webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated.

All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.
