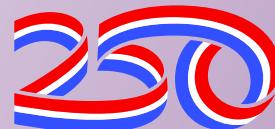

# NURSE'S NOTES

*Spotlighted Column Topics: cancer prevention, modifiable risk factors, progress over perfection*

The focus of this column two weeks ago was on how our healthcare system aims to raise awareness for cancer prevention and early detection, particularly in the months of February and April. In that February 22 bulletin, while I did focus primarily on colon cancer detection ~ aligning colonoscopy preparation for physical health to the rigors of fasting during Lent for spiritual health ~ I want to reiterate the importance of prevention and early detection efforts for *all* forms of cancer. Our understanding of cancer's intricacy and diversity continues to expand.

“Anything that increases your chance of developing cancer is called a **cancer risk factor**; anything that decreases your chance of developing cancer is called a **cancer protective factor**” (NCI, 2025, para. 7). Some risk factors are nonmodifiable, meaning they are beyond our control, unchangeable, and/or biological ~ such as age, genetics & family history, sex/gender, race & ethnicity, reproductive/hormonal factors. Each cancer type and subtype has its own set of risk factors, diagnostic criteria, treatment options, and evolving research. Tying in the concept of **nonmodifiable risk factors**, and as an example of each type of cancer having its own data points ~ Testicular cancer is predominantly seen in young men (ages 15-35), while prostate cancer is a disease of aging and thus more common over the age of 50.

While nonmodifiable facets are out of our control, there are also numerous **modifiable risk factors** for cancer. A recent study from the American Cancer Society asserted that **40% of cancer cases in the U.S. are preventable**, and **44% of cancer deaths in 2025 are attributed to behaviors you can change** (as cited in McDonald, 2026, para. 1). So how can we use modifiable risk factors to reduce our own risk of cancer? Below are some overarching modifiable risk factors (cancer prevention strategies) from the Cancer Research Institute (McDonald, 2026). 1. Don't Smoke (and Avoid Secondhand Smoke)
2. Alcohol: Less is Better
3. Maintaining a Healthy Weight & Staying Active
4. Eat for Prevention (Not Perfection)
5. Sun Safety Matters
6. Vaccines & Screening: Prevention Tools You Might Not Expect

## WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns, or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the [diojeffcity.org](https://diojeffcity.org) webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated. All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.
