You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

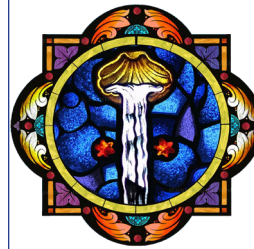

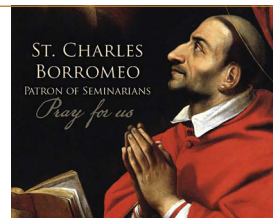

Remember to thank God for the beauty of flowers, plants and gardens bursting forth. Working with gardens or even house plants can lift your spirits. Remember, too, that May is the month of the Rosary – pray to Mary for peace and health and respect for all peoples, of all ages, and in all walks of life.

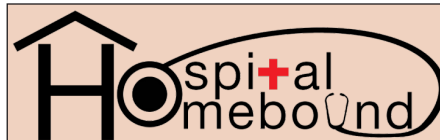
Spring cleaning time is here: Cleaning with a household cleaner that contains soap or detergent reduces the amount of germs on surfaces and decreases risk of infection from surfaces. Clean high-touch surfaces regularly and after you have visitors in your home. Focus on high-touch surfaces such as doorknobs, tables, handles, light switches, and countertops.

Clean other surfaces in your home when they are visibly dirty or as needed. You might also choose to disinfect with bleach, home sanitizer, sanitizer wipes, etc. Take steps in your home to limit contamination of surfaces from airborne particles or from touching surfaces with contaminated hands. Additional tip for those with kids and sandboxes: Keep bugs out of your kids' sandbox this summer with a simple, all-natural bug repellent: cinnamon! Just mix a cup of cinnamon in with the sand and it will repel ants, centipedes, flies, and even neighborhood cats.
