

- Meeting opened with a prayer
- Alice Kuehn gave a presentation on the duties of the Parish Nurse. She distributed a document that outlined her current job duties and gave a brief explanation of all she does. She proposed that we have a paid, part-time position offered for her replacement. Members were surprised to find out that she had worked for so many years as a volunteer. She was thanked for her commitment to St. Peter parishioners.
- Alice mentioned that there was a group in the diocese that helps get grants, etc. for certifications and training.
- We had 117 people at the Anointing Mass, which was an increase from last year.
- It was noted that with the loss of Paula Wekenborg as Director of Vogelweid, as well as the retirement of Alice as Parish Nurse, we are losing a couple of "institutions" in our parish.
- Monsignor gave an update of the Museum project. Monsignor distributed a first draft of the proposed museum layout in the Fr. Ahrens room. Alternate options were discussed, such as use of the Bishop Marling room.
- Council reviewed the current Pastoral Plan and discussed whether or not we are on track with the plan. Everyone agreed that we seem to be aligned with the plan.
- The budget was analyzed. It was noted that the preschool projected income was significantly lower that it should be at this time in the fiscal year. Beverly is to investigate and inform the council of her findings.
- It was recommended that the Property Committee present a budget proposal this year, to prevent over-spending. Ski mentioned that it would be helpful if they could show projected projects for a few fiscal years in the future, to help plan long-term spending.
- The next Finance Council meeting will be April 15, 2025.
- Monsignor ended the meeting with a prayer.
