Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.



UPCOMING ELECTIONS



PURPOSE

As described in Church Law, the Parish Pastoral Council is a structure of consultation and consensus. It is a planning council, not a coordinating council. It is a consultative planning group aiding the Pastor in the decision-making process.



It is the function of the Parish Pastoral Council to "investigate everything pertaining to pastoral activities, to weigh them carefully, and to set forth practical conclusions concerning them so as to encourage conformity of the life and actions of the People of God with the Gospel" (Motu Proprio, Ecclesiae Sanctae). Specifically, the Parish Pastoral Council is called upon to aid the pastor and every member of our parish to further the mission of Christ among us, in a coordinated and unified manner.

MEMBERSHIP

The St. Peter Parish Pastoral Council is composed of ten parishioners that serve three year terms. The terms shall be staggered so that one third of the lay member positions are brought up for election each year.



This year there are three positions open on the St. Peter Parish Pastoral Council. These three positions will serve from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2026. The Council meets a minimum of six times and up to eight times a year depending upon the needs of the Parish. 
