Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.



A new way to give to St. Peter Church!

St. Peter Church is currently in transition to Church Community Builder, a new way to manage our member information, ministries and scheduling. With this new system comes many advantages for our parishioners:

- The ability to register online, and manage your information in your parish record
- The ability to volunteer at any time of the year for ministries that interest YOU
- The ability to communicate with groups in which you volunteer/minister
- A new St. Peter Parish app so that you have information and the ability to give and volunteer anytime, on your phone



- Go outside and enjoy the sunshine and fresh air.


The U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services (HHS) has some additional suggestions for celebrating Women's Health including:
