UPCOMING SUMMER PROJECTS

An upcoming summer project on campus will be the replacement of the wall between the old garages and the Vogelweid Building.

This project is being undertaken because of the deterioration of the old masonry wall and the need to replace a portion of a late 19th century-era sewer line which runs under it. This project is being undertaken in collaboration with the City of Jefferson.

Another project that is already underway is the renewal of the hardwood flooring in the main hallway of the 1889 portion of St. Peter School. It was initially hoped to remove the old floor tile and refinish the maple hardwood underneath. However, as has been the case elsewhere, the tile was found to contain asbestos and so remediation is currently taking place.

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

CLOSING RALLY DINNER FOR SPRING 40 DAYS FOR LIFE



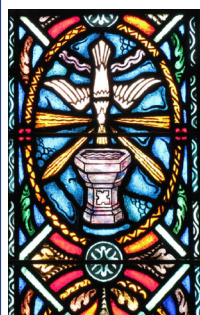

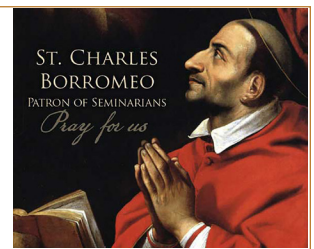

Memorial Day

Memorial Day is a United States federal holiday, commemorating those who have died in military service to their country. It is observed annually on the last Monday of May.



Memorial Day was originally known as *Decoration Day* - an occasion to decorate the graves of the war dead - and was created in the aftermath of the American Civil War. The focus for that day expanded after World War I to include all service personnel from all wars who lost their lives in service to the United States. Observances are held at military graveyards, cemeteries and memorials, and military themed parades are held across the country.

Memorial Day, and the long weekend that it creates, is generally seen to mark the beginning of the summer season (while Labor Day marks the end). In 1915, following the Second Battle of Ypres, Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae, a physician with the Canadian Expeditionary Force, wrote the poem “In Flanders Fields.” Its opening lines refer to the fields of poppies that grew among the soldiers’ graves in Flanders. In 1918, inspired by the poem, YWCA worker Moina Michael attended a YWCA Overseas War Secretaries conference wearing a silk poppy pinned to her coat and distributed over two dozen more to others present. In 1920, the National American Legion adopted it as their official symbol of remembrance.

Let us honor and pray for all those who have died in service to our country, and reach out to those veterans who served and are in need of our help. May God bless them all and help us to work together for peace.
