



WHISTLEBLOWER HOTLINE

The Diocese of Jefferson City has updated their website to include a new whistleblower hotline that anyone can use to report financial misconduct, human resources concerns or any other issues. **The hotline number is: 573-635-0386.** Information about the hotline is available at the top of the **diojeffcity.org** webpage via the "Report Abuse or Misconduct" link. This page also includes instructions for the existing methods of reporting abuse. The new whistleblower hotline is available in both English and Spanish. Callers are prompted to leave a message with their concerns. The message will immediately be sent by email to three people — one Chancery employee and two lay people who are not employees of the diocese. The three will confer and ensure the issue is properly investigated. All parishes are encouraged to inform the faithful about the whistleblower hotline and to use it for any concerns that arise.

BREAKING THE SILENCE OF ABUSE

As a diocese, we are committed to breaking the silence of abuse. When someone is reporting abuse, we must acknowledge their pain and how difficult it is to talk about. False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. For those who need to report abuse, encourage them to contact our Victims Assistance Coordinator, Jacqueline Baldwin, (573-694-3199) and to make use of the appropriate State of Missouri hotline (1-800-392-3738) or the Attorney General's clergy abuse online form. IMPORTANT NOTICE — PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Purpose

As described in Church Law, the Parish Pastoral Council is a structure of consultation andconsensus. It is a planning council, not a coordinating council. It is a consultative planning group aiding the Pastor in the decision-making process. It is the function of the Parish Pastoral Council to "investigate everything pertaining to pastoral activities, to weigh them carefully, and to set forth practical conclusions concerning them so as to encourage conformity of the life and actions of the People of God with the Gospel" (Motu Proprio, Ecclesiae Sanctae). Specifically, the Parish Pastoral Council is called upon to aid the pastor and every member of our parish to further the mission of Christ among us, in a coordinated and unified manner.

Membership

The St. Peter Parish Pastoral Council is composed of ten parishioners that serve three year terms. The terms shall be staggered so that one third of the lay member positions are brought up for election each year.

Nominations

This year there are four positions open on the St. Peter Parish Pastoral Council. These four positions will serve from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2027. The Council meets a minimum of six times and up to eight times a year depending upon the needs of the Parish. 

"The Eucharist is my highway to heaven."

These are the words of Blessed Carlo Acutis who was beatified on October 10, 2020, and whose remains are displayed in Assisi, Italy. This 15 year old teen cultivated a friendship with Jesus Christ, placing the Eucharist and the witness of Charity at the center of his life. The quote above is engraved on the reliquary that contains his heart in the Shrine of the Renunciation at the Church of St. Mary Major. Known as the site where a young St. Francis renounced his father's inheritance and embraced poverty, the shrine, like the city of Assisi and St. Francis himself, held a special place in Acutis' heart. He would attend Mass twice daily. He was like most teenagers, he was tech-savvy, loved soccer and hanging out with friends. But he also found time for Christ in his daily life. He gave witness that faith does not distance us from life but immerses us more deeply in it. What an incredible example for all of us to try and emulate. Let us be like him.


