Am I My Brother's Keeper? Yes, We Are!

Following the release of Bishop McKnight's August 21 Decree, the following REVISED protocols are now in effect for all Masses — Weddings and Funerals included — at St. Peter Parish until further notice.

Please know that we are carefully monitoring all directives and guidelines issued by state and local governments, as well as by the Diocese of Jefferson City, and will re-evaluate and adjust these protocols as warranted.

HEALTH — All the faithful are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice provided the Lord's Day is kept holy by participating in the live-streamed Sunday Mass; praying with the readings of the Sunday Mass; and/or reciting the rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet. Those with underlying health issues are encouraged to avoid the risk of large public gatherings such as Sunday Mass. Please check your temperature and general well-being before coming to church. Those who are symptomatic for COVID-19 are not permitted to enter church. Pews and hard surfaces are sanitized after each Sunday Mass.

MASKS – Masks are strongly enouraged upon entering the church, throughout the Mass, and while moving in the Communion Procession to receive Holy Communion. If approaching to receive Holy Communion, please remove your mask just prior to receiving Our Lord, and moving it to cover your mouth and nose while returning to your pew. Please bring a personal mask with you. Ushers will have a limited supply for those who forget to bring a mask and would like to wear one.

DISTANCE – Pews in the front of the church are now open. We strongly encourage everyone in the front pews to wear masks. The pews in the back of the church will remain in their current configuration of every other pew open to parishioners. Please follow the directions of our ushers and any signs or markings on pews and aisles.

HYMNALS & MISSALETTES – All hymnal have now been returned to the pews. Missalettes will be returned to the pews after Pentecost Sunday. A limited quantity of current Missalettes are available on the rectory porch for your personal use. If you pick up a Missalette please take it home with you. Weekly bulletins are currently available in the mailbox at the rectory porch. We will continue to post the song texts for Sunday Mass on our parish Facebook page and parish website.

HOLY COMMUNION – Please follow the directions of the ushers and any floor marking to maintain the six-foot distance between the faithful in the line. Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand or on the tongue. For those wishing to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, a kneeler is also provided for your use. The Ministers of Holy Communion will sanitize their fingers after distributing Holy Communion on the tongue of each individual.

TITHING – Thank you for your continuing generosity in this challenging time. Please continue to make use of automatic bank drafts, mailed contributions, or placing envelopes in the slot on the rectory porch. There will also be a stationary basket placed in the center aisle during Sunday Masses so that you may leave your contribution there.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK— If at all possible please seek the anointing of the sick from the parish priest before going to the hospital. We cannot guarantee that a priest will either be available or allowed into the hospital because of pandemic protocols.

A NOTE REGARDING THE 8:00 AM WEEKDAY MASS ON TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY

Please note that the 8:00 am Weekday Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday is when the children from St. Peter Interparish School attend Mass. Due to COVID restrictions the children are required to sit in certain pews and next to designated individuals.

If you are an adult attending the 8:00 am Weekday Mass please sit in the back of the church to ensure the students are able to follow the necessary protocols for them to attend Mass and remain safe.

A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR...

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord,

by this point you've no doubt observed the emergence of the restored church steeple from under the web of scaffolding. I hope that you are pleased by the work which I has taken place. By next week, weather permitting, the remaining scaffolding

should be removed from

church.

What remains to be accomplished is the completion of some stonework, tuck pointing and water-sealing of the church tower brick which has been inaccessible because of the scaffolding. On the original St. Peter School, the removal of



four previous roofs on the uppermost portion occurred this past week.

Although current local building code only allows for two layers

of roofing material on any building at any one time; somehow over the decades, the required tear-off of previous roofing materials was not accomplished.

I'm happy to report that all of that extra weight has now been removed and additional ventilation has been added, bringing the building into building code compliance for attic space ventilation as well. Later on, additional insulation will be added to the attic space.

Finally, I want to thank all of you who attended in person, or have viewed online, the presentation that was given on Friday, April 23 with Bishop McKnight and William





Heyer for the interior restoration work in church. A detail that was not mentioned on that Friday evening, but one which has been asked about, is the cost.



MASS INTENTIONS

There is inestimable value in the offering of Holy Mass. Our Catholic faith has a long and wonderful tradition of having Masses offered for our loved ones living and deceased. If you wish to have a Mass or Masses offered for a loved one, contact our Parish Office at (573) 636-8159.

Having assembled all of the necessary job quotes for carpentry, asbestos abatement throughout church, new woodwork for pulpit base and railing, sanctuary and nave hardwood flooring, two renovated confessionals, the refinishing of all of the current pews, the creation of new pews and the installation of new kneeler hardware and pads, the total cost of the interior restoration will be \$345,000. Keeping in mind that this work is being done in concert with the planned renovation of St. Joseph Cathedral, Bishop McKnight has agreed to fund half of the project. I appreciate greatly the expressed willingness of some of you to contribute to the project. Obviously, more details are to follow.

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.


SEASONS OF HOPE


