





PREPARING FOR CHRISTMAS

Advent is the time for us to "ponder anew what the Almighty can do..." Let us also ponder what we can do to prepare for His coming. Advent is a wonderful time to pause amidst the busyness of our daily life and to be more attentive to our spiritual, mental and physical health. The Advent and Christmas Seasons get filled up with a lot of stuff, so take a look at your busy schedule and see if you can plan less and relax, pray and meditate more. Maybe you could read some of Luke's gospel readings of the Nativity every day. Consider participating in some of the Advent liturgies and activities as a specific way to prepare for His coming.
