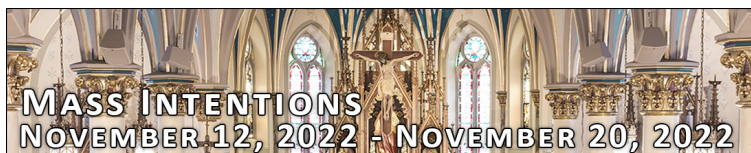

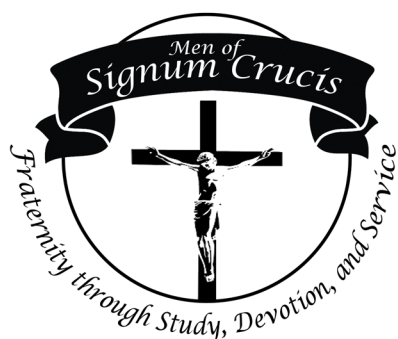

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

Anointing of the Sick

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

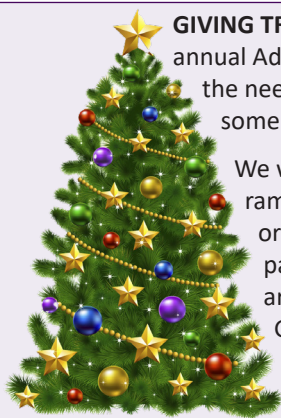

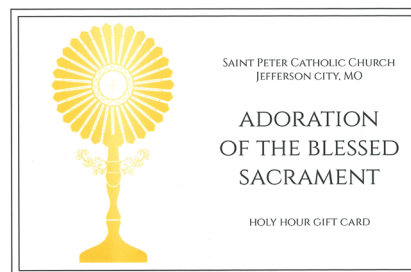
- Meat for the meals has been donated and the Knights of Columbus will prepare it. Thank you!

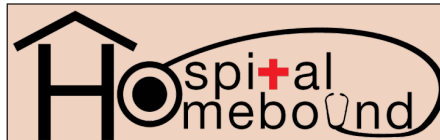
ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES

As you plan and then celebrate your Thanksgiving meal this year, remember to give thanks for the bounty of healthy food we are privileged to enjoy and pray that there will some day be food on the table for everyone. And as you prepare your feast, consider the following IDF (International diabetes Foundation) recommendations for a healthy diet:

- Choose water, coffee or tea instead of fruit juice, soda, or other sugar sweetened beverages.
- Eat at least three servings of vegetable every day, including green leafy vegetables.
- Eat up to three servings of fresh fruit every day.
- Choose nuts, a piece of fresh fruit, or unsweetened yoghurt for a snack.
- Limit alcohol intake to a maximum of two standard drinks per day.
- Choose lean cuts of white meat, poultry or seafood instead of red or processed meat
- Choose peanut butter instead of chocolate spread or jam.
- Choose whole-grain bread, rice, or pasta instead of white bread, rice, or pasta.
- Choose unsaturated fats (olive oil, canola oil, corn oil, or sunflower oil) instead of saturated fats (butter, ghee, animal fat, coconut oil or palm oil).

A particular threat in terms of the associated risk of developing type 2 diabetes is the consumption of high sugar foods, particularly sugar-sweetened beverages. See the [IDF Framework for Action on Sugar](#).
