FIRST FRIDAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Begins Thursday, December 1, 2022 at 8:00 pm and ends with Benediction on Friday, December 2, 2022 at 7:45 am in the Chapel.



The purpose of the Liturgy of the Hours is to sanctify the whole day. The Second Vatican Council described it as "the voice of the Bride addressed to her Bridegroom; the very prayer which Christ Himself, together with His body, addresses to the Father." Vespers, or Evening Prayer, helps us to give thanks to God for the blessings we have received throughout the day and to offer up an evening sacrifice of praise. The Second Vatican Council specifically instructed that Vespers be celebrated in common in churches, especially on Sundays. During Advent, we'll be doing just that here at St. Peter, and we hope you'll join us!

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

Anointing of the Sick

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.
