BAPTISM

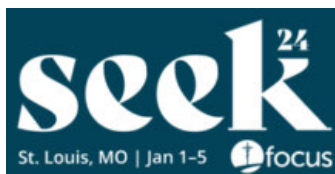

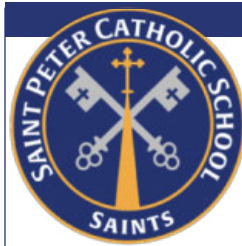
