RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION AT THE RAIL

With the restoration of the Communion rails to a functional location at St. Peter Church, here are some practical instructions.


Those who desire to receive Holy Communion at the rail - either kneeling or standing - are invited to come forward at Holy Communion and spread out along the full length of the rail, not just at the end closest to the aisle. A priest or deacon will make his way back and forth along the rail, so there's no worry that you'll be missed. If you kneel to receive Holy Communion, there is no need to bow or genuflect before receiving as kneeling itself is a proper show of reverence to our Eucharistic Lord.

As you are patiently waiting to receive Your Lord in Holy Communion, please be contemplating the One whom you are to receive. The reception of Holy Communion is not about the rapid speed at which a task needs be accomplished so that we can move on, but rather about the Lord's People receiving the Lord of Life.

Many people find receiving Our Lord on the tongue is more natural and more comfortable due to the height at which the Host is distributed at the rail. Although they have not yet arrived, please know that kneeler pads are on order in order to aid your knees.

Once you have received the Host, prayerfully make your way back to your seat in church in order to give thanks for the great Eucharistic gift.

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.



ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

REMODELING AND ASBESTOS:

"Asbestos fibers may be released into the air by the disturbance of asbestoscontaining material during product use, demolition work, building or home maintenance, repair, and remodeling. In general, exposure may occur only when the asbestos-containing material is disturbed or damaged in some way to release particles and fibers into the air. Exposure to asbestos increases your risk of developing lung disease. That risk is made worse by smoking. In general, the greater the exposure to asbestos, the greater the chance of developing harmful health effects".

So how do you protect your family from exposure to asbestos?

"Generally, you can't tell whether a material contains asbestos simply by looking at it, unless it is labeled. If in doubt, treat the material as if it contains asbestos and leave it alone. You may want to have your home inspected for asbestos-containing materials by a trained and accredited professional if:

- You are planning to remodel your home (remodeling can disturb building materials)
- Your home has damaged building materials (like crumbling drywall and insulation that is falling apart)

A trained and accredited asbestos professional should take samples for analysis, since a professional knows what to look for, and because there may be an increased health risk if fibers are released. In fact, if done incorrectly, sampling can be more hazardous than leaving the material alone.

Taking samples yourself is not recommended. If building materials in your home aren't damaged and won't be disturbed, you do not need to have your home tested for asbestos. Material that is in good condition and will not be disturbed (by remodeling, for example) should be left alone". (Above information taken from EPA web site). 
