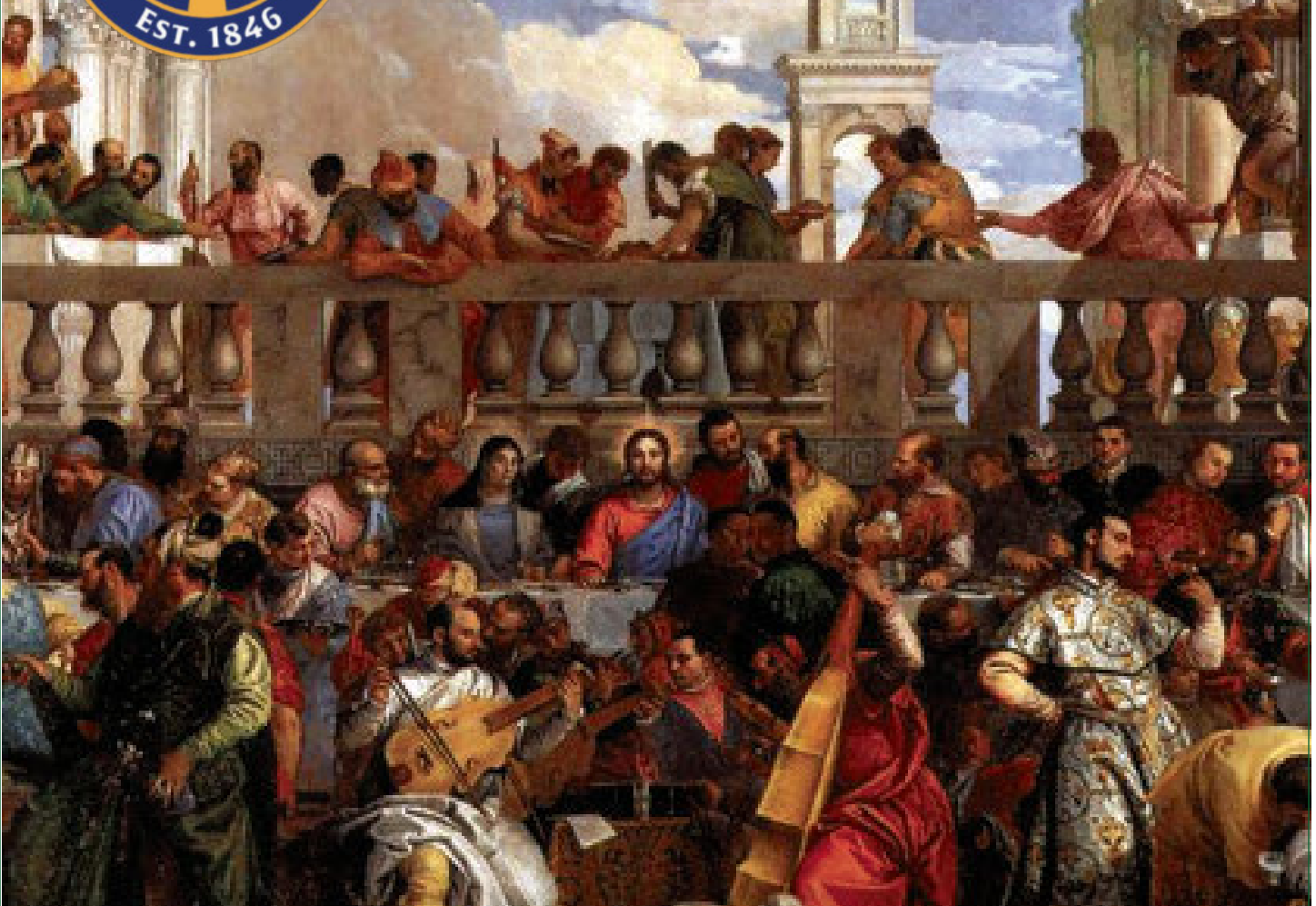

BAPTISM

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

text but to immediately block the phone number. If you respond then the scammer knows they have reached a real person.

False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. Those who need to report abuse are encouraged to contact our Victim's Assistance Coordinator, Jacqueline Baldwin (573-694-3199), and to make use of the appropriate State of Missouri hotline or the Attorney General's clergy abuse online form.
