

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

FLU SEASON IS HERE! Influenza (the flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses. It can cause mild to severe illness, and at times can lead to death. Some people, such as young children, older people, pregnant women and people with certain long-term health conditions are at high risk for serious flu complications.

The single best way to prevent the flu is to get a flu vaccine every year. The vaccine typically is redesigned each year to contain flu virus strains expected to be prevalent during the upcoming flu season. The strains have been inactivated so that they don't cause you to get sick with flu, but will trigger your immune system to produce antibodies that can protect against influenza disease.

Seasonal flu activity can begin as early as October and continue to occur as late as May, most commonly peaking in the U.S. in January or February. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and the CDC recommend

that virtually everyone six months and older get the flu vaccine before the end of October, if possible. It is especially important for children younger than 5 years of age, pregnant women, adults 65 years of age and older, people who live in nursing homes or other long-term care facilities, people who live with or care for those at high risk for complications from flu, and people with certain chronic medical conditions who are at a higher risk for developing flu-related complications.

A high-dose quadtrivalent shot is approved for people 65 and older because human immune defenses become weaker with age, which places older people at greater risk of severe illness from influenza. Also, aging decreases the body's ability to have a good immune response after getting influenza vaccine. A higher dose of antigen in the vaccine is supposed to give older people a better immune response, and protection against flu.


